Kacie asks Asim, who has nearly finished eating.

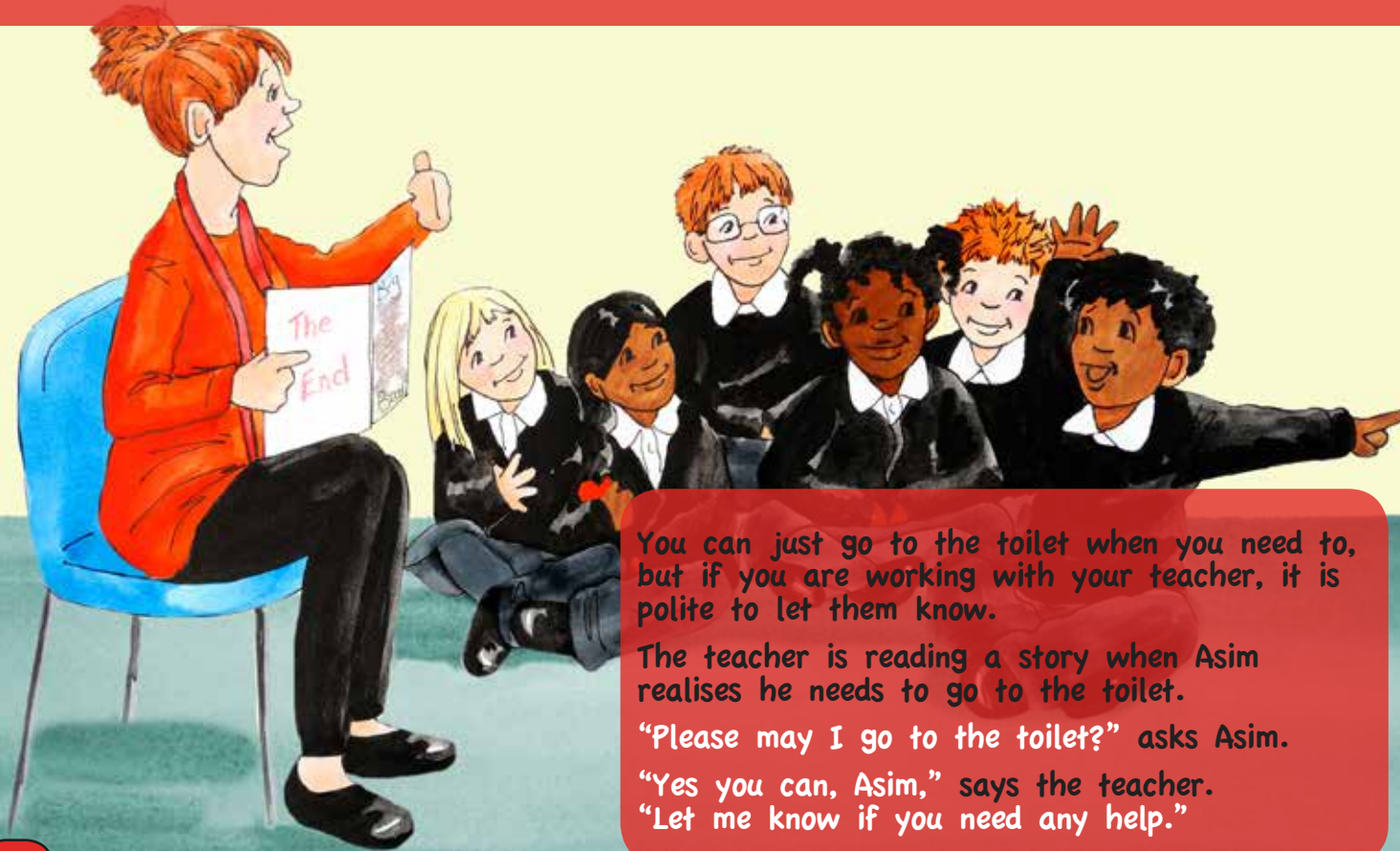
"I am having peas," replies Asim.
