
Zara, Aaliyah and Logan are excited to be starting at St Matthias C of E Primary School

You will put your water bottle on the circular table in the classroom.


Your grown-ups will help you write your name on the whiteboard. Then your grown-ups will say goodbye.

What will I do in school?






If you need the toilet, you can just go. If you are working with your teacher, it is polite to let them know.




Aaliyah goes to the toilet.

What happens at the end of the school day?


When school is finished for the day, you will come together to sit on the carpet. This is a special time when you will have a story and talk about your favourite activity of the day.

Their teacher is reading a lovely story about children having fun in the park. She then asks the children what they have most enjoyed doing that day.


"I loved cooking with Ben," says Aaliyah.
