What happens when I get to Nursery?


When you arrive at Nursery, you will say goodbye to your grown-ups at the gate. You will then go into Nursery and hang up your coat and a bag with some spare clothes on your special coat peg.

You will find your name on the table for you to put on the wall. The kind grown-ups will help you find your name.

You will practise doing fine motor activities, such as a puzzle.

Imani has found her coat peg.




Once everyone arrives, you will sit on the carpet and welcome everyone. Then you will have a chat about your news and talk about what you are going to do in Nursery that day.

What will I do in Nursery?

You will have lots of fun in Nursery. You will play and learn indoors and outdoors. You will soon make friends with the other children in your group.

The children are having story time with their teacher. They are all sitting quietly and listening to the exciting story.

"Can you help me climb out, please?" asks Imani.

Sophie gives her a hand. They are having fun playing together and making friends. Dalip, Imani and their new friend Tom are threading some string. It is lots of fun and helps their fingers get used to managing fiddly things.

You will have a drink and a snack when you are at Nursery. Before snack time, you will use the toilet and wash your hands, so they are nice and clean before you have some food.

Dalip is washing his hands. He can't wait to have his snack.

At snack time you will sit on the carpet with your key person and friends. There will be fruit to eat and a drink of milk or water. Then you will listen to a story or sing together.

"Would you like a tangerine, Mina?" asks Sophie. "Yes, please. They're

my favourite," says Mina. Sophie is kind and she is making lots of new friends.



What if I need the toilet?

If you can use the toilet by yourself at home, then you can go to the toilet by yourself at Nursery. If you would like some help, just tell your teacher.



Dalip needs to use the toilet so he is telling his teacher.

"Can I go to the toilet, please?" he asks.

"Yes, you can, Dalip. Please let me know if you need any help," says his teacher. The toilet door is in the Nursery Room, so the toilets are easy to find.

Dalip is using the toilet. He knows he needs to leave the toilet ready for the next child. He will flush, wash his hands with warm water and soap, and dry them carefully.





What happens when Nursery is finished for the day?

If you are here in the morning and staying for your lunch and for the afternoon, a teacher will come and collect you and take you to have your lunch. Afterwards you will play until the afternoon session starts.

When it is time for you to go home, you will be collected by your grown-ups.

In your school bag, you will take home activities to do with your grown-ups. There will be books to look at and talk about.

You will take home 'busy bags' which have shapes and numbers in them to practise with your grown-ups.


It is lots of fun to practise what you have been learning at Nursery, and it helps you get ready for going to school.
