A good balance

We think they have a great balance between nurturing and focused learning. Jack's very happy there and loves learning!"

A lot of the staff are very experienced at Milking Bank Primary School and have been at the school for a number of years, which Natalie believes is a real strength of the school: "You can tell the teachers enjoy their job by their enthusiasm for the children, by how much enjoyment they get from watching the children grow and learn and from the way they know so much about them. It's an indication of a good school for me when the staff choose to stay for so long. "You can always approach the teachers if you have any concerns," adds Natalie. "We've had very few issues, but in Reception we found them very helpful when offering guidance on how we could support Jack at home."
