What can I do if someone is being unkind to me or another child?



Sometimes people may use unkind words or hurt you or your friends. If this happens even once, tell a grown-up, such as your parent or carer, or one of the grown-ups at school. The grown-ups will know what to do and it will be OK.

Never think that this is your fault. The bully is the person who has done something wrong. It is OK to be different and it does not give anyone the right to be unkind to you.

Also remember to use kind words and be gentle with your friends.

What should I do if someone is being unkind to me online?

Sometimes people can be mean online. Your grown-ups can help protect you from this by making sure that they keep an eye on what you are looking at. Always use your device in an area of your home where your grown-ups can see what you are looking at.



At school we will make sure that you are protected too.



Tell a grown-up

If someone says something unkind to you online, or you see something upsetting, or someone is asking you to do something that you wouldn't do face-to-face, tell a grown-up straightaway and stop using your device.



It is good to tell. You will not get in trouble and it will be OK!

Do you know what to do if someone is being unkind to you online?

What happens if someone hurts me by accident?

Sometimes someone may bump into you and hurt you, or may use words which upset you. If this happens to you, think about if this is an accident. If it is an accident, try to accept their apology and not get annoyed or sad.



If you bump into someone, or say the wrong thing, say sorry and make sure they are OK.
