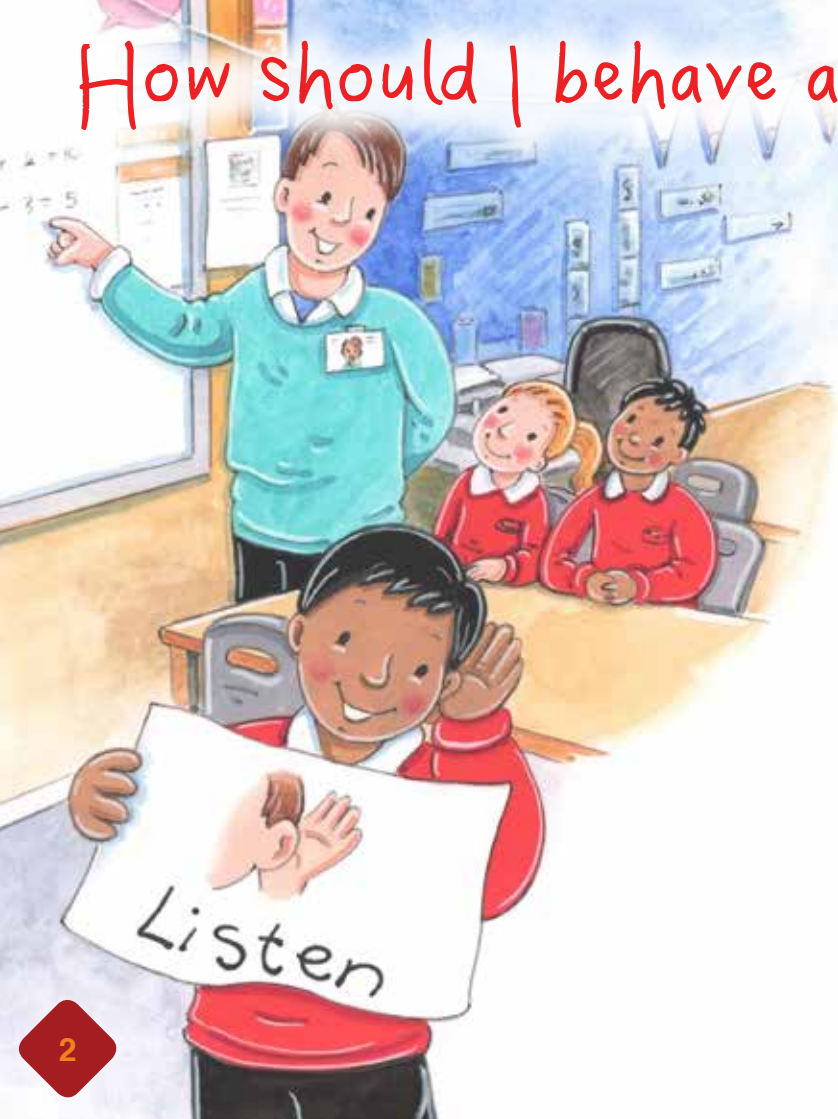




Keeping safe and

How should I behave at IQRA to keep it a kind and happy place?



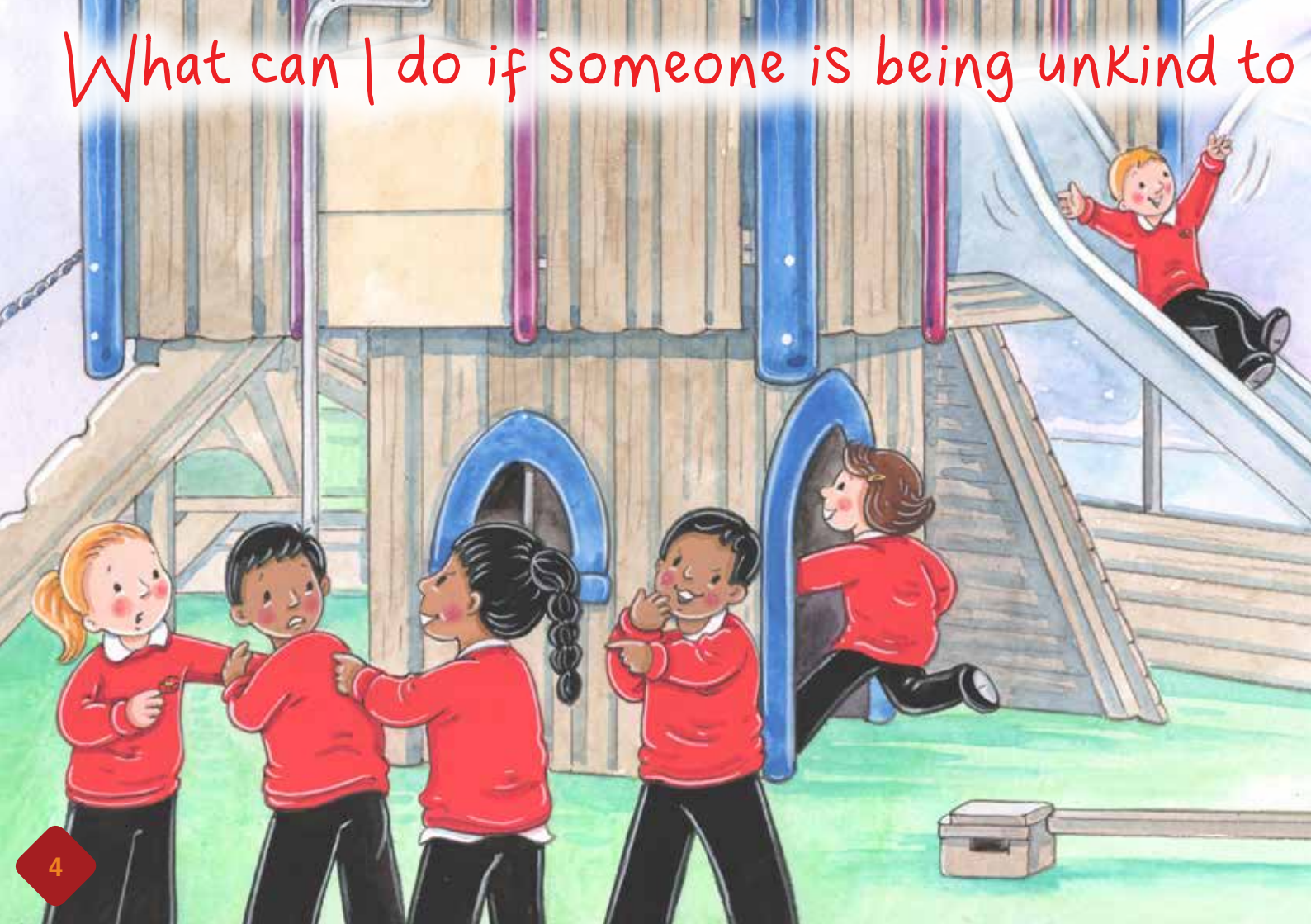
Our children follow these rules so everyone feels safe and happy:

1. Listen at all times ✓
2. Be polite and courteous ✓
3. Look after ourselves and others ✓
4. Look after our school and everything in it ✓
5. Always tell the truth ✓
6. Try to do our best at all times ✓
7. No bullying ✓
8. Treat people how you would like to be treated ✓



Can you follow these rules?

What can I do if someone is being unkind to me or another child?



Sometimes people may use unkind words or hurt you or your friends. If this happens even once, tell a grown-up, such as your parent or carer, or one of the grown-ups at school. The grown-ups will know what to do and it will be OK.

Never think that this is your fault. The bully is the person who has done something wrong. It is OK to be different and it does not give anyone the right to be unkind to you.

Also remember to:

- use kind words and be gentle with your friends
- be respectful and tolerant of others.

Tell Someone.

Sometimes people can be mean online. So always use your device in an area of your home where your grown-ups can see what you are looking at. Show them if you see something you don't like.

At school we will make sure that you are protected too.

Tell a grown-up if:

- someone says something unkind to you online
- you see something upsetting
- someone is asking you to do something that you wouldn't do face to face.

Make sure you stop using your device straightaway and only use it again when your grown-up says it is OK.

It is good to tell. You will not get in trouble and it will be OK!

What happens if someone hurts me by accident?

Sometimes someone may bump into you and hurt you, or may use words which upset you.

If you bump into someone, or say the wrong thing,

say sorry and make sure they are OK. Then they won't be sad.

We have playground pals who help children play at break and lunchtimes.

They wear yellow baseball hats so you know who they are.

They will play with you and help you find friends to play with.

A playground pal is going to help Muhammad after he fell. They will make sure he is OK. We also have a buddy stop. This is a red sign in the playground where children can go to if they want a friend to play with. Jack is at the buddy stop and Anisha will find him some friends to play with.

...we share with each other

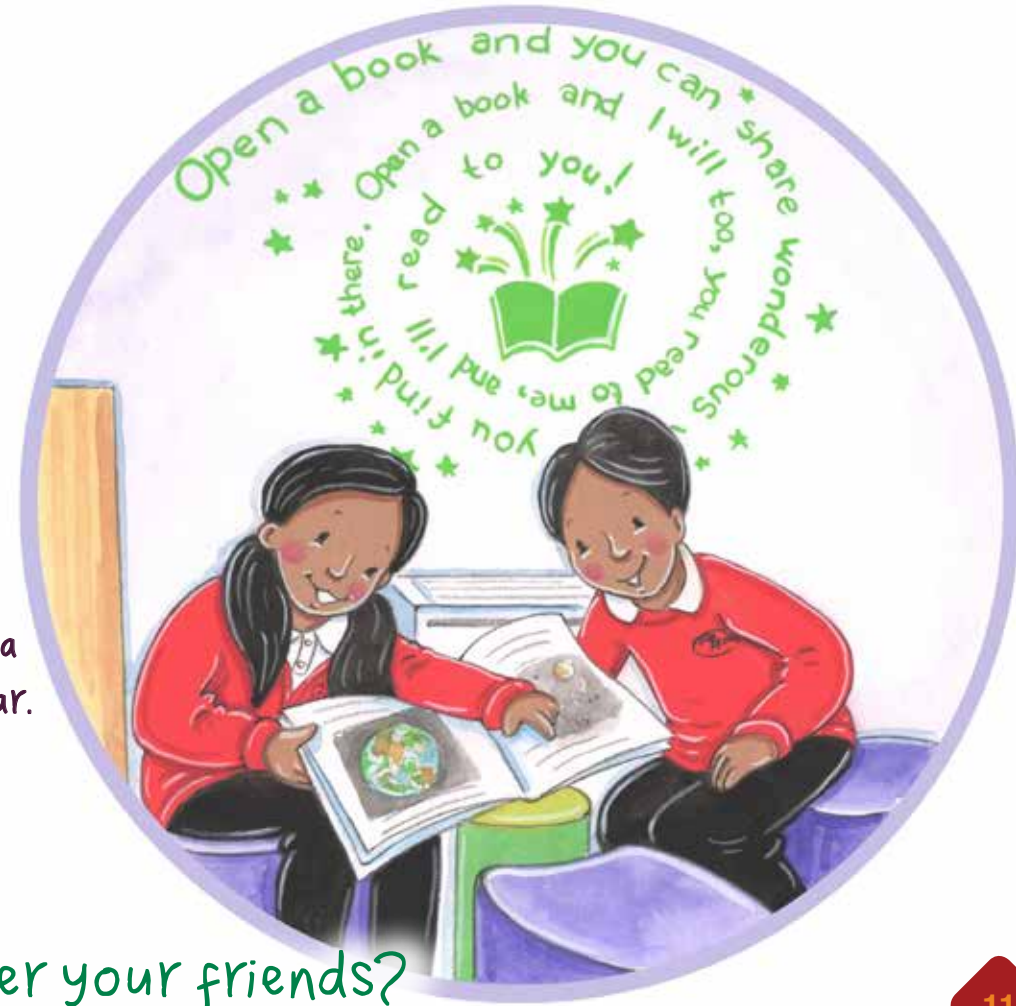
...we are kind and helpful
