Question: are you good at making friends? Its ok to be shy ... everyone is different.

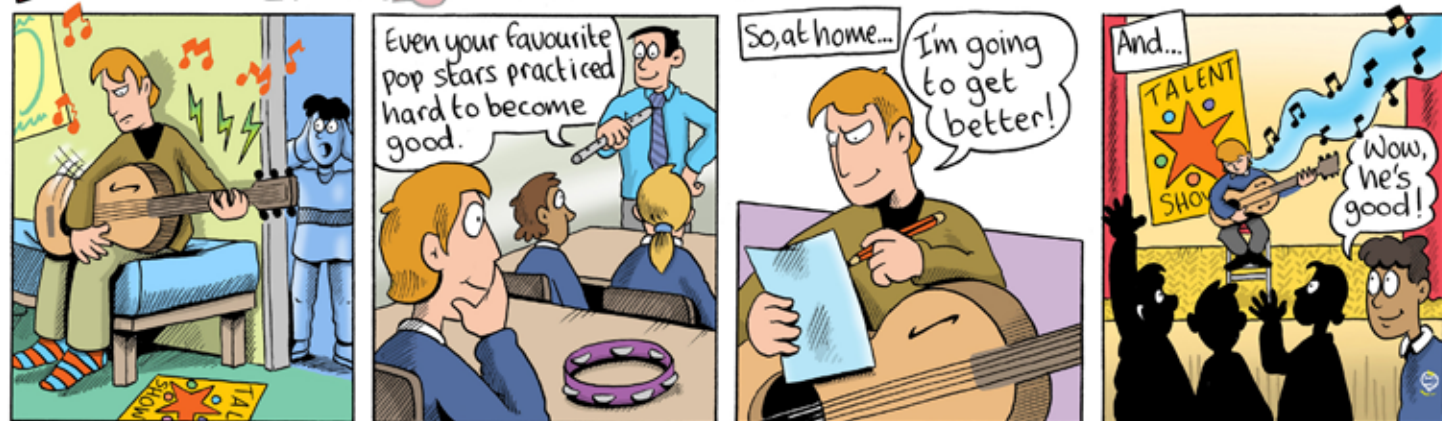
A FOR AANYA IN ALGEBRA

Question: do you struggle with Algebra? If you do ... then mention it to your teacher.

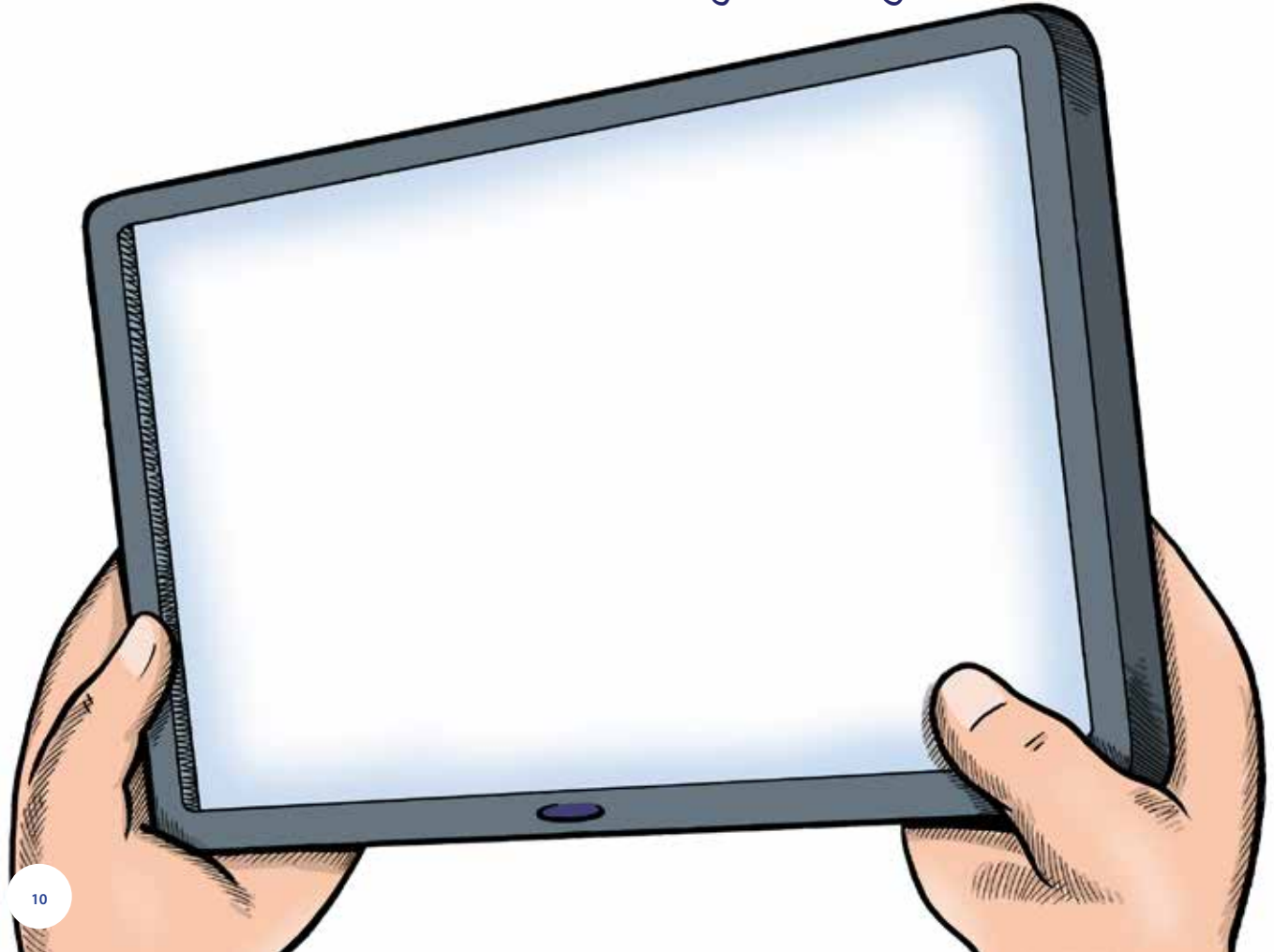
RICHARD ROCKS THE HOUSE
