Your grown-ups will bring you to the nursery door and say "goodbye". Your teacher will be there waiting to welcome you in.


You will be in red, blue, green or yellow group and you will do lots of activities with your group. Dev is in the red group.

Then you will collect your name card from the board and put in on the Velcro strip above your coat.




What will I do in nursery?

"They are very nice," says Tom.

"Yes, please," says May. "I love apples."

The children are enjoying sitting and chatting while they have their snack.

The teacher is going to read them a story when everyone has their snack.



What happens when I need the toilet?



You can go to the toilet whenever you need to. If you are doing an activity with your teacher, just tell the teacher that you need to go as this is polite.

"I need to use the toilet," he says.


"Let me know if you need any help," the teacher says.

Dev knows that if he ever needs help or has an accident, he can just say "help me, please" and his teacher will be there straight away to help.




Dev goes to the toilet. He loves the beautiful doors, and he is very pleased that everything is just the right size for him.
