What happens when I come to nursery?

Your grown-ups will bring you to the front gate and say “goodbye” to you.

The headteacher will welcome you into nursery. Your teacher will then take you to the cloakroom, where you will hang up your coat on your own peg.



You will register yourself by putting your photograph on the classroom whiteboard. You will then write your name on your own whiteboard.



Mei is putting her picture on the board. “I practised writing my name at home,” she says, “so I can write it on my whiteboard!”

Once you have registered, you can have fun playing with your friends.

What will I do in nursery?



You will do lots of fun activities in nursery. Amir is painting with blocks. "Look at my painting," he says.

You will soon make friends with the other children as you play.

Mei and Tim are reading together. "I love to read books," says Tim. "I can choose what I want to read from the bookshelf."

In nursery you will have phonics lessons, where you learn to recognise words and letters by their sounds. You will also have maths, dancing on the carpet and 'group time'.



You can play inside and outside.

We also have 'Muddy Mondays' and 'Welly Wednesdays', where you can have extra play outside with mud and water.

Everybody is playing outside on a 'Welly Wednesday'. "I'm splashing in a puddle," says Amir.

What activity would you like to do in nursery?

What happens when I am hungry or thirsty?

If you are thirsty during the day, you can have some water. You will also have a healthy snack time, where you will be given fruit and milk or water. Before you have your snack, you will wash your hands.

During snack time you will share food and have a nice chat together.

"Please can I have some fruit?" asks Amir. "I love bananas."



If you are staying for lunch, you will have a packed lunch in the classroom.

There will be lots of kind adults in nursery to help you with snack time and lunch.

What happens when I need to go to the toilet?

You can go to the toilet whenever you need to. You can ask an adult if you want help or if you have any problems.

The toilets are near the classroom. They are very easy to find and everything is just the right size for children.

Amir is washing his hands to make sure they are clean and to stop germs from spreading.

"I love the bubbly soap," says Amir.

Amir practised going to the toilet at home, wearing his uniform, so he would know what to do in nursery.



At the end of the nursery day, you will help tidy the classroom while music is played. You will then listen to a story on the carpet.

When your grown-ups arrive at the gate, your name will be called and your teacher will take you out to your grown-ups.
