She washes her hands with warm water and soap. She loves the bubbles that help her get her hands really clean. Then Aisha dries them and she goes back to her class.



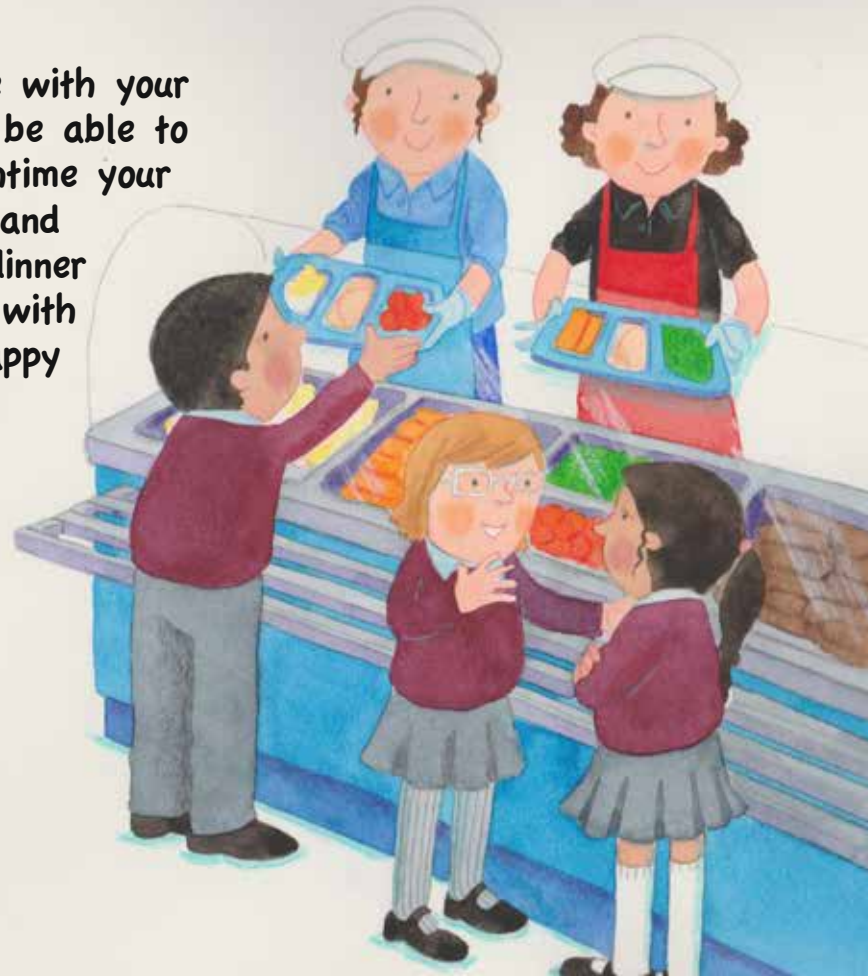
Have you remembered to wash your hands?

Aisha and Isabelle are chatting to their new friend Kendra about what games they like to play. They plan to ask their other friends to join in so no one feels alone and left out.

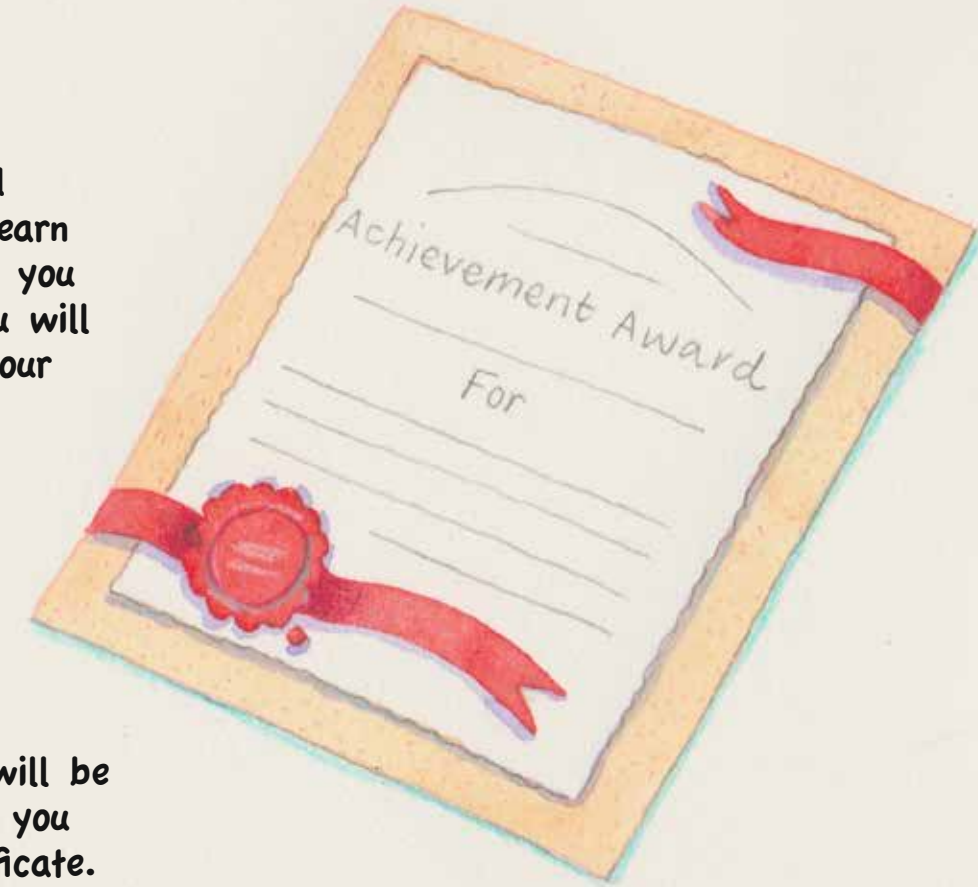
Are you going to be kind, polite and work hard to achieve your very best?
