


What happens when I get to school?

"Please may I go to the toilet?" asks Tyler.


"Yes, of course, Tyler," says his teacher. "Off you go and we will see you back here soon."

When he has finished, he makes sure he flushes to leave the toilet nice and clean for the next child who uses it.


He washes his hands with warm water and soap and dries them before going back to class.


Tyler is so pleased that he practised going to the toilet on his own at home so he could remember everything once he started school.
