


Zahra, Joshua and Mia are coming to Kents Hill Infant Academy

If you brought a lunch box from home, you put this on the trolley.


If you are having a school lunch, you put your name against the picture of the dinner you would like to have.

What if I am hungry or thirsty?




You can have a drink of water and a snack from the snack table whenever you feel hungry. Remember to wash your hands before you eat anything.


Zahra and Joshua are having their snack together.


"These apples are really juicy," says Zahra. "It is fun having a snack with friends."


The children are waiting to go out to their grown-ups. Zahra and Mia have been playing together a lot today.
