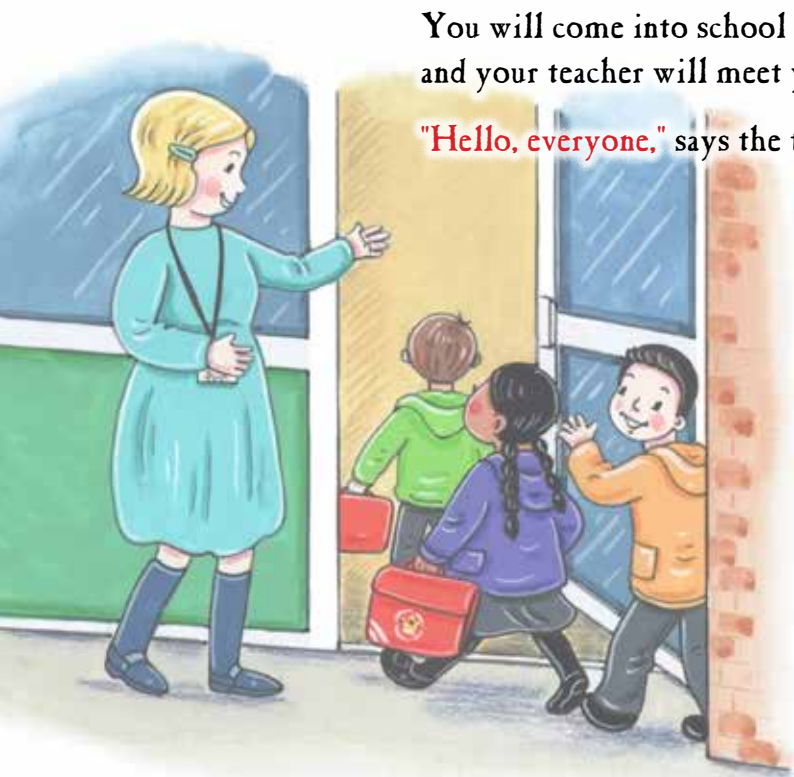


Millie, Danny and Hannah are

You will come into school with your grown-up and your teacher will meet you at the door.

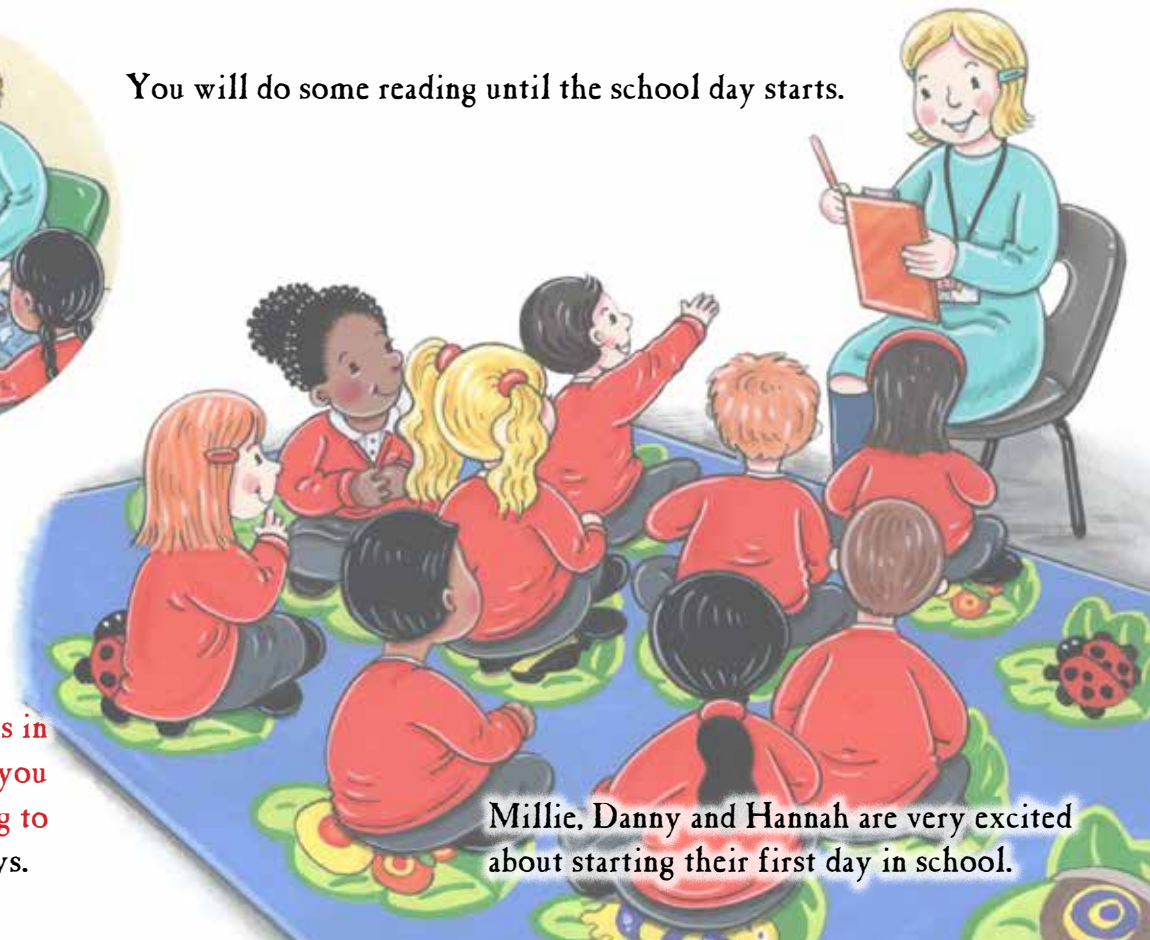
"Hello, everyone," says the teacher.

You will have lots of fun learning as you play and explore, and you will make friends with the other children in your class.

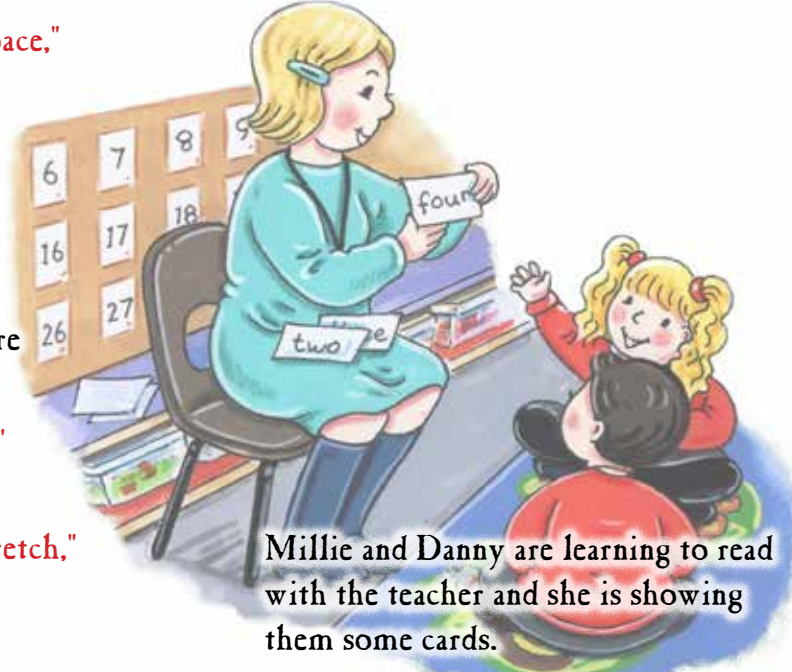
"Shall we look at this book together?" Hannah asks.

Danny and Hannah are practising measuring.

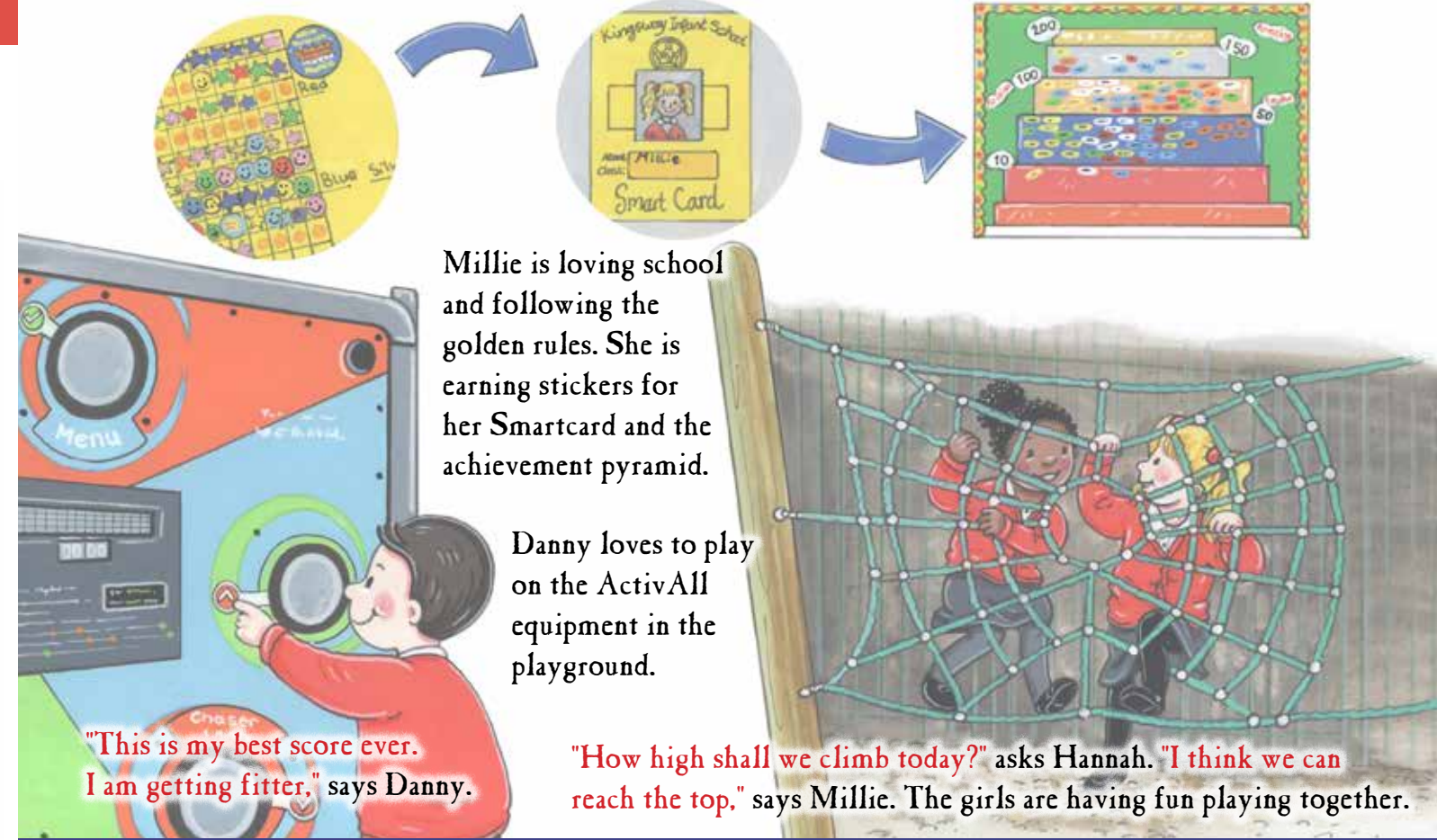
"Look how tall I am," says Danny.
