




Olivia, Harry and Isaac are excited to be starting in Nursery at Lingey House Primary School





What happens when I get to Nursery?




Your grown-up will then take you to your classroom door where they will say goodbye to you as your teacher welcomes you into your classroom.

Olivia, Harry and Isaac think it is great fun learning new things and making


What are you looking forward to doing at Nursery?

What happens if I need the toilet?




You can just go to the toilet when you need to, but if you are working with your teacher, it is polite to let them know. If you need any help, just tell them.


Harry had been drawing with his teacher's help when he needed to go to the toilet so he let his teacher know. His teacher said it was OK.

Olivia and her friends are listening to a lovely story about children living in other countries.


"Has anyone been abroad?" the teacher asks.
