
Gracie, Nivan and Elian are starting infants at New Invention Infant School


What will I do in school?

What are your favourite games to play?


What happens if I need the toilet?

You have a morning snack time. Elian, Gracie and Nivan are enjoying their fruit and vegetable snacks while they sit on the carpet. You can also sit at a table.






What happens at the end of the school day?
