


What happens when I come to nursery?

caterpillars





"I don't want to spread any germs," says Nivan to himself.






What happens if I am thirsty or hungry?

Gracie is thirsty so is having a cooling drink. "That's better," she says. "Now it's time to go back and play with my friends."










What happens at the end of the nursery session?
