Confidence is believing that you can do it! We will all support you when you try new things, such as telling your class about something you have learnt.

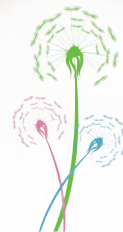
Creativity is about thinking about things in different ways or creating something such as a story, art or music. We will encourage you to develop your imagination and experiment without worrying about making mistakes.
