We are lucky to have the RAF Marham station very close and they love to visit us or have us visit them.

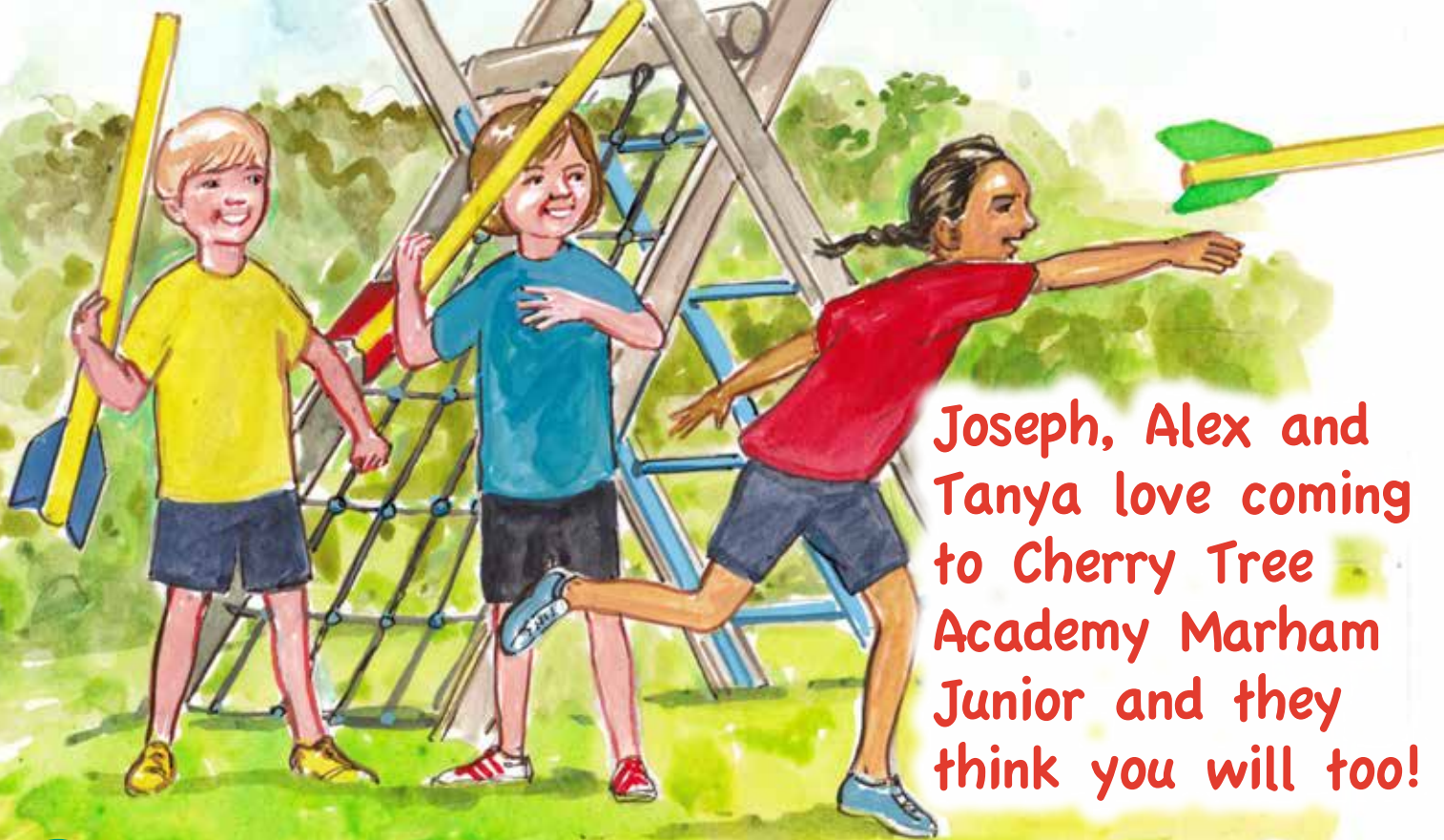
They come into school to help children with projects like go-kart building.
