



You should arrive on time, attend school every day and be ready to learn. We have three values for how everyone is expected to behave.


1. Ready: ready to learn.

There are lots of inter-house competitions in singing, sports, maths and spelling.


If you have done something special at school, 'positive postcards' will be sent home to your family to let them know.
