


How will you help me settle in at the Junior building?

What are you most looking forward to when you start at Kestrel Mead Junior building?


What new work will I do at the Junior building?

You will still explore Big Questions relating to these topics.






There are brilliant facilities for you to use, including the multi-use games area (MUGA), ping-pong tables, library and school hall.

What clubs and extracurricular activities can I continue to take part in?








There is even a school cooking club!
