You are still at the same school even though you are at a different building and you will see lots of familiar faces.

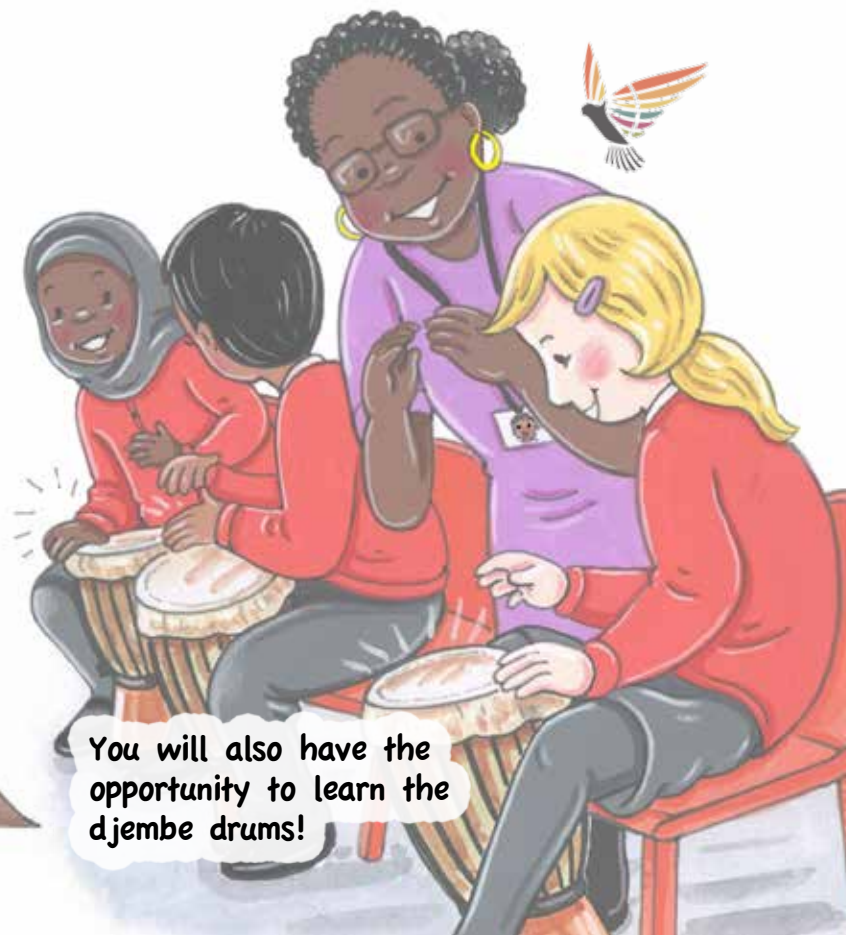
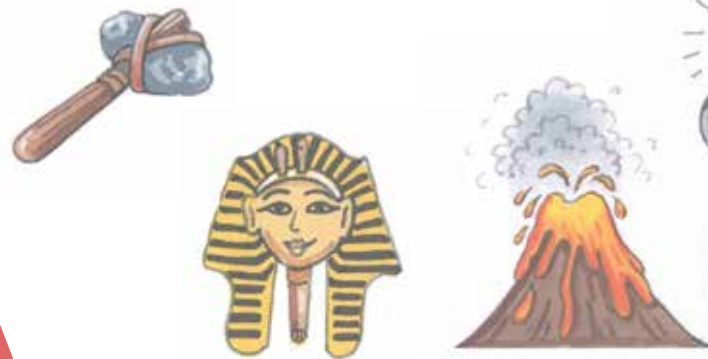
What are you most looking forward to when you start at Kestrel Mead Junior building?

Your learning journey at Kestrel Mead will continue in the Junior building.

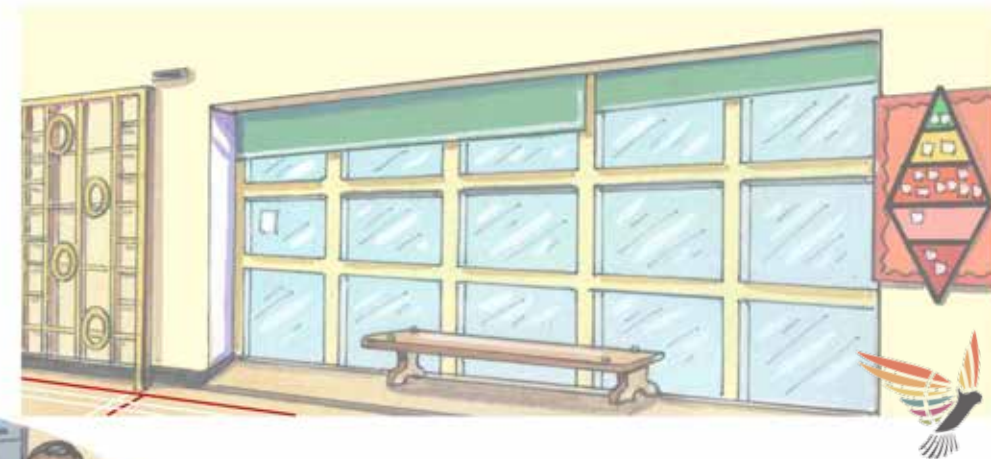
You will do **English, Maths, Computing, Geography, Art, Music, History, Religious Education, PE, Modern Foreign Languages, PSHCE** and **DT**.

You will also have the opportunity to learn the djembe drums!

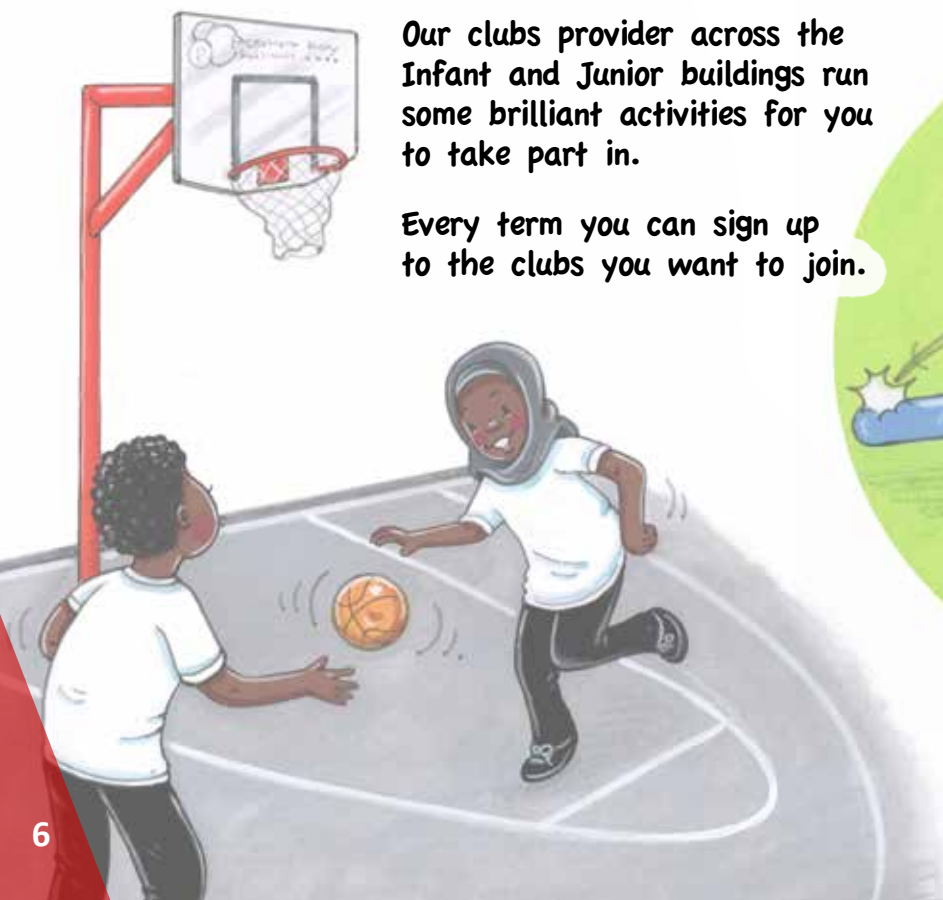
There are brilliant facilities for you to use, including the multi-use games area (MUGA), ping-pong tables, library and school hall.



We go on fantastic trips to support your studies and help you learn. You will go to museums, places of worship, local historical sites and lots more. They will enrich all of your learning!

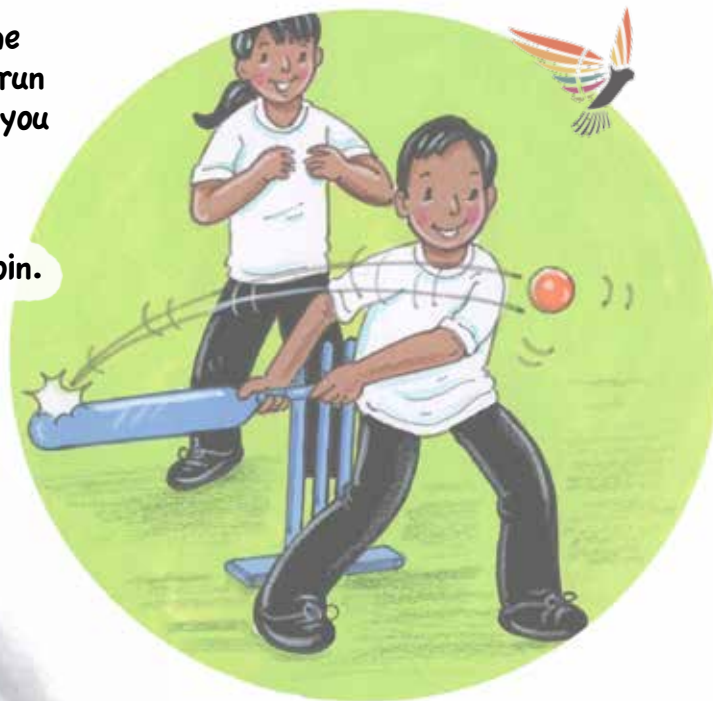
What are you looking forward to learning more about?

What clubs are you looking forward to taking part in?

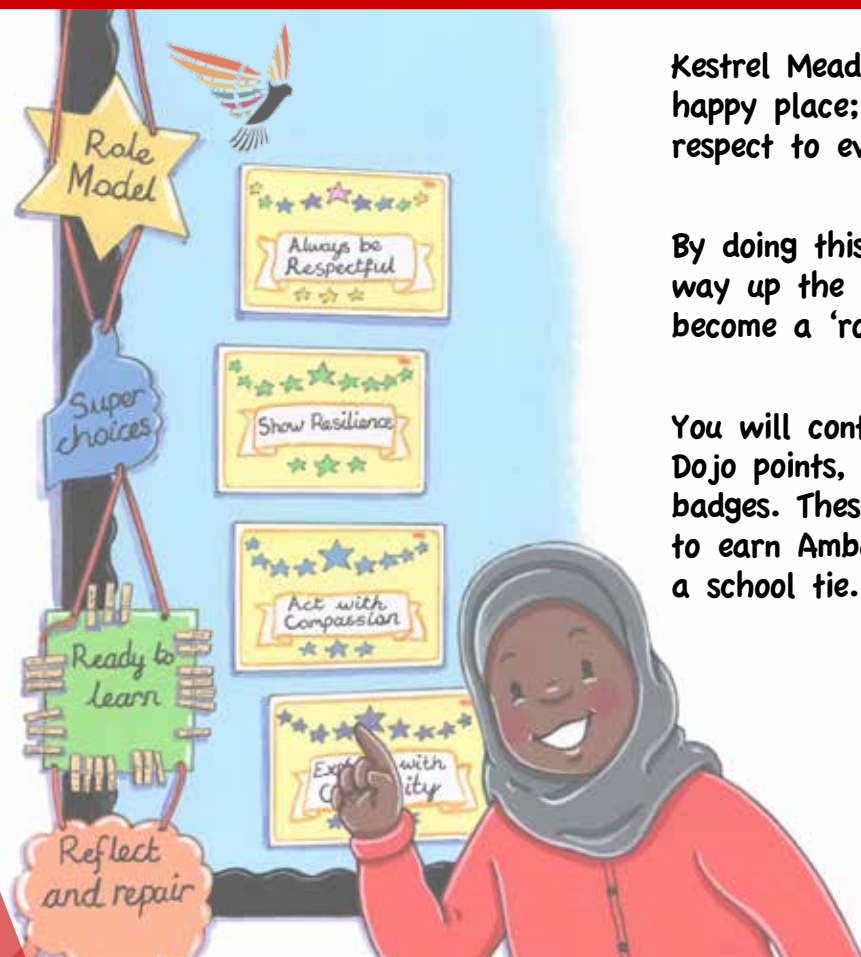
What will my Junior teachers expect of me?
