## FINDING YOUR WAY

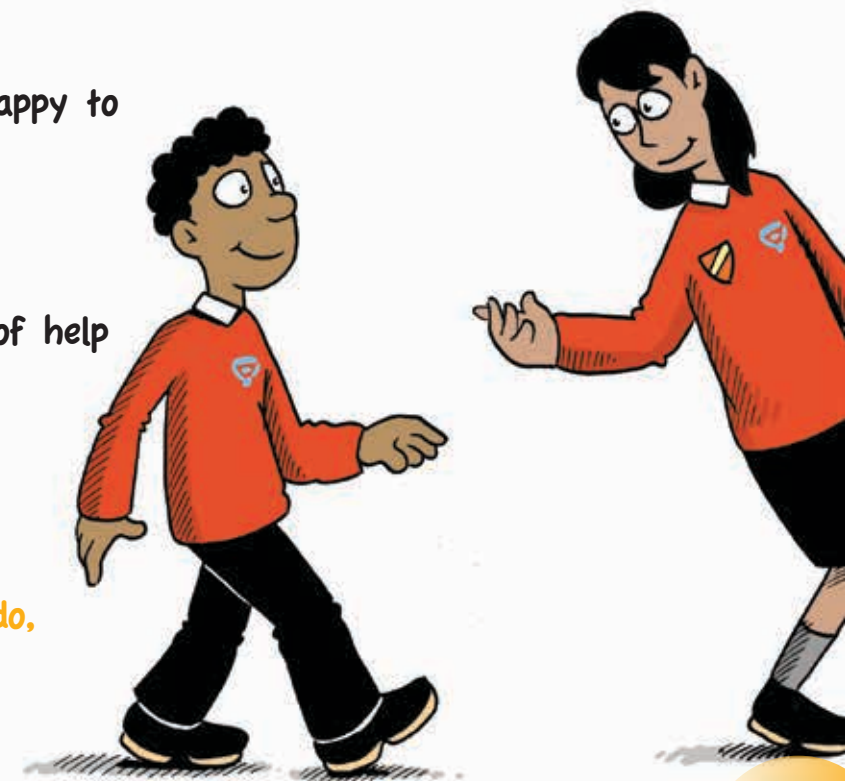
We will make sure that you have lots of help finding your way around.

## COMMUNITY

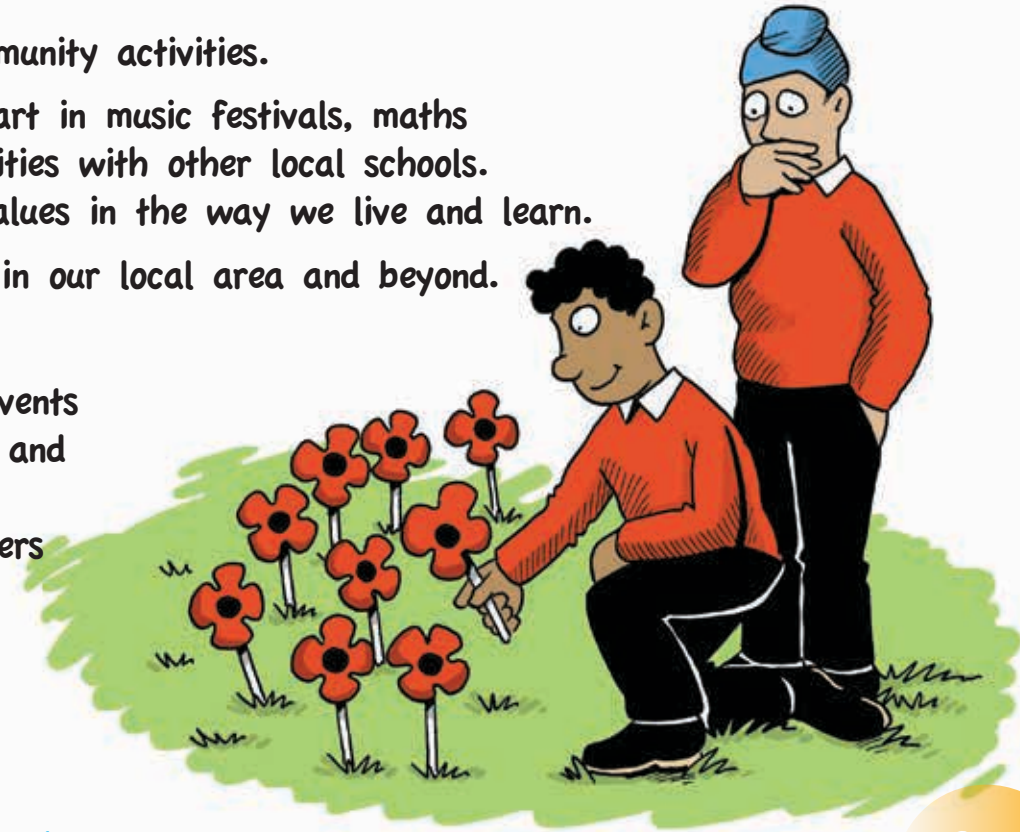
We take part in lots of community activities.

Ajay is cheering on his friends. He is really happy to see them doing so well.

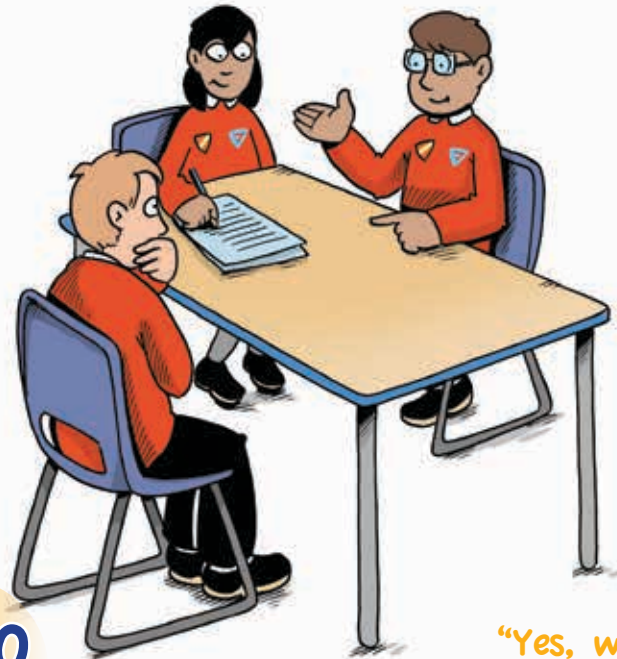
