


How will you help me settle in?

AUTUMN: Respect and Friendship


Through Friendship Days we will help you to make friends with children in our school and other schools... and you will have fun taking part in Art, Science, I.T. and Sport.

SUMMER: Responsibility and Adventure


We will help you to be more responsible and work in teams effectively, and encourage you to challenge yourself by taking part in new activities and school visits.
