

How will St Peter's CofE Academy help me get ready for secondary school?

We can't wait to welcome you to St Peter's CofE Academy, and we have put together this booklet to help you prepare and feel confident about what to expect when you arrive.

Starting secondary school is a big step and we understand that you may feel a little nervous, which is completely normal. We will do everything we can to make your move to our Academy as easy as possible for you.

To help you get ready, you will have an induction programme, which will include two induction days.

## Induction days

We have two induction days where you will meet your new teachers, get used to finding your way around the Academy building and learn more about the school and what to expect when you join us.

How should I prepare for my first day?

We are very proud of our uniform at St Peter's CofE Academy and from your first day we have high standards of presentation.

On days when you have a PE lesson, you will wear your PE Kit to the Academy. You will also need a rain jacket and base layers.

## **Equipment**

You will need a sensible bag, big enough to carry books and the following equipment: black, purple and green pens, pencils, ruler, highlighters, rubber, pencil case, scientific calculator, maths set, mini dictionary and a reading book which will be used every morning during line-up and ROCK.

You will also be given a Student Organiser and access to a free locker.

Your mobile phone must be switched off at the Academy gate and then be kept out of sight.

Make sure that everything has your name on it, including your uniform, so things can be returned to you easily if they are mislaid.

# What happens on my first day at St Peter's CofE Academy?

Plan your route to the Academy beforehand, so you know how long your walk or journey will take.

When you arrive, you will enter the Academy at the main gate. You will be greeted by teachers who will tell you where you need to go and what you need to do.

You will then head to morning line-up for a message from your Head of Year. You will also do some reading while you are in the hall.

Then it will be time for ROCK, which means you will go to your tutor group before the rest of your day begins.

"Don't worry if you don't know anyone when you first start with us. There will be lots of other students in the same position and you will make new friends quickly."



Everyone at the Academy knows what the first day feels like, so we all do as much as possible to make you feel welcome and help you settle in.

You will find everyone is friendly and welcoming and you will soon make new friends.

Don't worry about getting lost around the Academy - there are lots of people around to ask and to help you.

By the end of the first week, you will find that you know the Academy very well and will have already started making new friends.

Every day there are 5 periods for your lessons. Morning line-up will start at 8:30am and the Academy day finishes at 3pm. You will move around the building for different lessons.
