# Goddard Park Community Primary School

has something for the older

Ron and Phyllis Bailes have lived in Park North for many years, and their children both attended Goddard Park Community Primary School, which is now an integrated Children's Centre.

## PART OF THE COMMUNITY

Ron and Phyllis attend the Tuesday lunch club at the Community School, run for the local senior citizens. "It's a nice place, and the people who run it are ever so friendly," says Ron. "Two of the year five children come along to help, bringing the meals and helping to clear away, and they seem to like the change in routine, just like we do. It's nice to get out for a meal once a week, and at £2.50 it's quite a bargain." After lunch the senior citizens and children play scrabble or bingo (which is really English and Maths!).

## TOP MARKS FOR SCHOOL MEALS

The club members have the same meals as the children, and, says Ron, he's got no complaints. "Some people say that school meals aren't very exciting, but we are very happy with what we have. Sometimes there's a roast, or they might do lasagne, shepherd's pie or fish, and there's always a pudding such as jam tart or fruit salad."

## A REAL ASSET

The Community School is much bigger now than when Ron and Phyllis's children went there, but Ron feels it's a real asset to the area. "There's always something going on there, especially now it's been extended. I think it's a nice touch to offer the lunch club for local people, and the head teacher usually comes to say hello and make us feel welcome."
