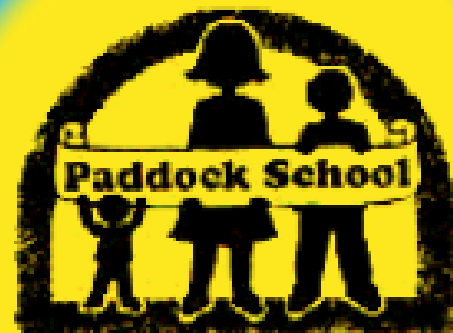


Emma believes that if you find a place like Paddock Nursery, Infant and Junior School for your children, you never want them to leave
