


Your Pocket Guide



What do I wear for my first day?


It is important to wear the correct uniform. We have high standards of presentation from the very first day.

- Basic stationery such as a pen, ruler and eraser.




The Ballakermeen Learner and ePraise

We will be working hard to embed these attributes and values across the school and we want all our students to understand their importance.

ePraise gives you the opportunity to see how well uou are doing at school and also links directlu with The Ballakermeen Learner.

You will be given points for demonstrating any of these characteristics and values, in both your work in lessons and your conduct around school.

Your points can earn you entry into prize draws, allow you to buy items from the shop and count towards your House's points.



What happens on my first day?

- You need to arrive no later than 8 40am.
- You will meet your Form Tutor and the other students in your tutor group.
- You will spend periods 2 and 3 with your Form Tutor in your tutor room.
- You will have your photo taken for your smart card and you will be shown how to use your smart card.
- You will be given your school planner and you will write your timetable into your planner.
- · You will learn all about ePraise points.
- Your lessons will begin at period 4, which is after break.

What happens in a school day?

English Art French History


PE Maths Drama Geography
