


What will I wear to school?

What will I need for my first day?


You will need:

Values

Canon James Slade founded our school in 1855 so that pupils could grow in a community that takes God seriously, teaches and practises the Christian faith, and encourages students and staff to grow in their understanding of Christianity.

St Paul's letter to the Galatians (5.22-23) describes the attributes we want to see in all our young people:

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law."

Steps to Success

Steps to Success rewards are given for good behaviour and a positive attitude to learning. You will receive a reward when you achieve higher totals of 1s and 2s.

You will begin each lesson with a 2 for Accepting the Challenge. When you show that you are determined to succeed, you will be given a 1. We will apply three sanction points for lost learning, four sanction points for being selfish and unkind, and five sanction points for dangerous behaviour.

Students who complete their homework learn more and develop better study habits than those who do not.

In Key Stage 3, you will get one piece of homework in English, maths, science and RS to complete each week. For all other subjects, you will get one homework task every fortnight. Each piece of homework should take you approximately 30 minutes to complete. If you have not been set homework, you should spend half an hour self-quizzing using your Knowledge Organiser.
