


What do I wear for my first day?

What will I need for my first day?

- A suitable bag to carry your books and other equipment.
- Basic stationery, such as a pen, pencil, ruler and eraser.
- A snack and lunch if you are not purchasing those from the canteen. To buy food and drink from the canteen, you must credit your account online via ParentPay, or you can bring in cash to upload to your account using the machines in The Boulevard. You can buy a meal deal for £3.

You will have the chance to work with students from other year groups in your House, including the Sixth Form.


House Stars

What happens on my first day?



- You need to arrive no later than 8.40am.

- · You will be given your school planner and write your timetable into your planner.
- · You will learn all about Malbank and have another tour of the site.

What happens in a school day?

Each school day will look like this:

8.45am-9.00am: Registration 12.20pm-1.00pm: Lunch 9.00am-10.00am: Period 1 10.00am-10.20am: Break 10.20am-11.20am: Period 2

11.20am-12.20pm: Period 3

1.00pm-2.00pm: Period 4 2.00pm-3.00pm: Period 5 3.00pm: Dismissal Time

Moving from primary to secondary school is a big change, and it is normal to have worries. Don't bottle up your feelings. There is always someone available to chat to.


Tips

Work out your schedule every week to include homework.


What else can I do at Malbank?
