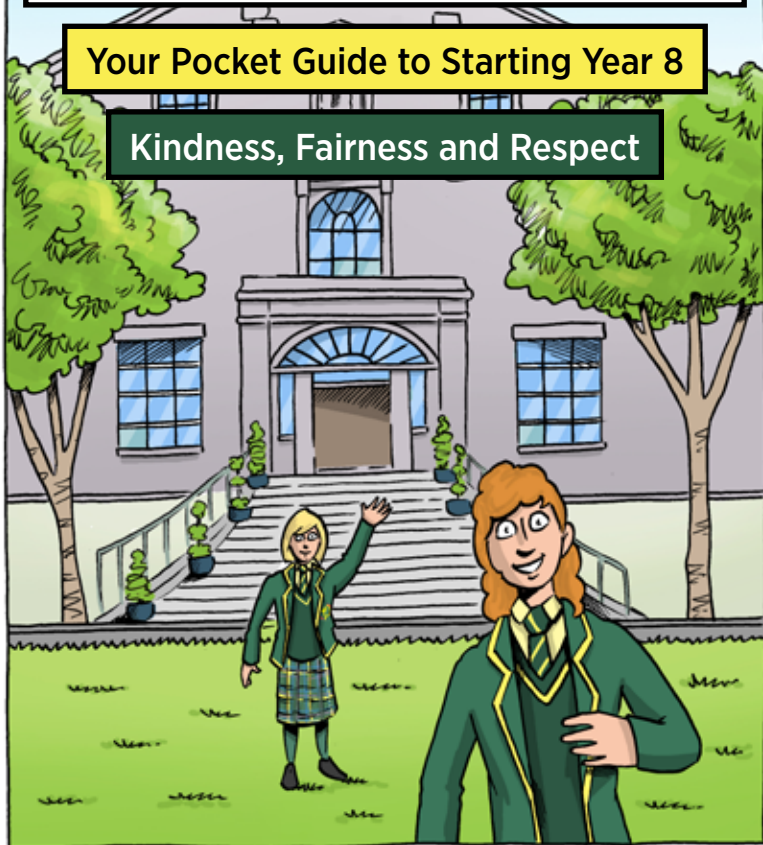

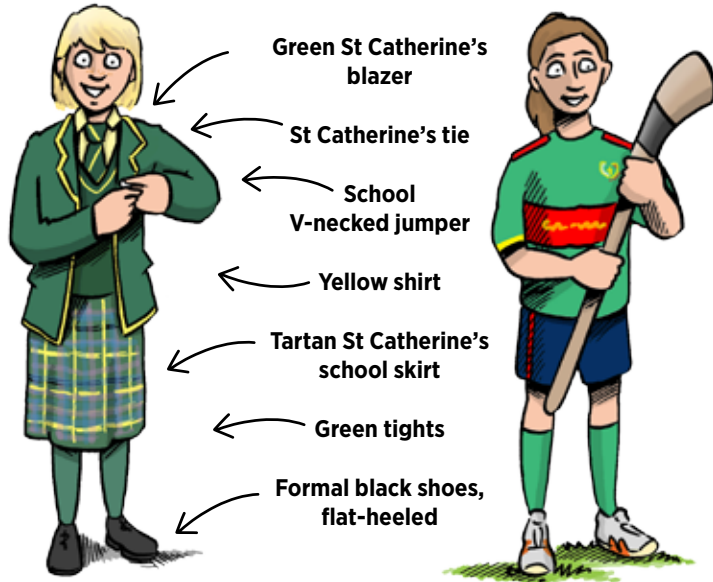

What do I wear for my first day?

Your parents/carers can pay money in via the app or you can credit your account by paying cash in via the machines in the canteen. Once your account has credit in it, you 'pay' for your food using your fingerprint. It is so easy!

What will happen on my first day?

- You need to arrive no later than 8.50am.
- You will meet your Year Head and the other students in Year 8.
- You will spend the first day with your Form Tutor in your form room.
- You will have your photo taken.
- You will be shown how to use the cashless canteen system.
- You will be given your school notebook and a copy of your timetable.
- You will learn about 'Positive Behaviour'.
- You will go on a tour of the school with your 'befriender'. They will be an older girl who will answer any questions you have and help you to settle into St Catherine's College. You can identify befrienders by their white shirt and 'B' badge.

It may seem like a lot to take in. But don't worry - you will soon feel at home and know how everything works!

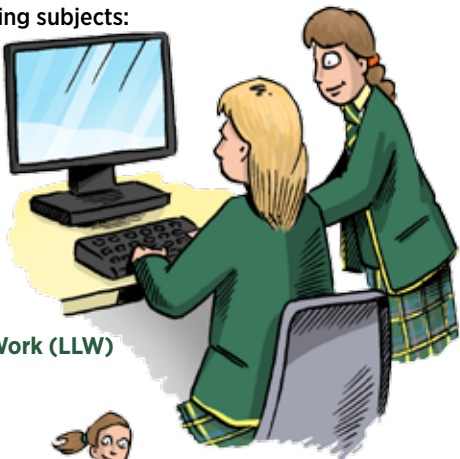
