# Happy at school

"Initially we had to get used to the different systems and the variety of apps used for communicating with parents, but we were invited to attend a talk for new parents, where everything was explained clearly, and this really helped. Ana came out buzzing after her first day at Cardinal Newman and we could tell she was very happy. The children are assessed after the first few weeks and are then put into sets for some of the core subjects. Ana was unsure about this



to begin with because she wasn't with some of her friends, but she has adapted well."

#### Varied activities

"There are lots of lovely after school clubs put on by the teachers that are free of charge and open to all the children. Ana has chosen to do Drama, Music and Netball so far and has really enjoyed them. She has also been given the opportunity to learn the piano during the school day, with a tutor coming in from outside that we pay for. Her favourite subject at school is Drama and we think she will probably want to do it for GCSE. Her father is an actor and she enjoys practising his lines with him. She also loves Maths. We have just received her second school report and she is achieving above expectations in almost everything." Ana says: "I am pleased there are lots of after school clubs so everyone can get involved and that there is something for everyone."

#### Good values

Helen says: "Cardinal Newman have high expectations of the children and we are happy with the ethos of the school and the way Catholic values are embedded in all that they do. Ana sang in the

choir for the school Easter service, 'Peter's Passion' and students get opportunities to celebrate all the other Christian festivals too. It is important to get the balance right to suit everyone at the school and we think Cardinal Newman achieve this well.
