# What happens when I get to school?

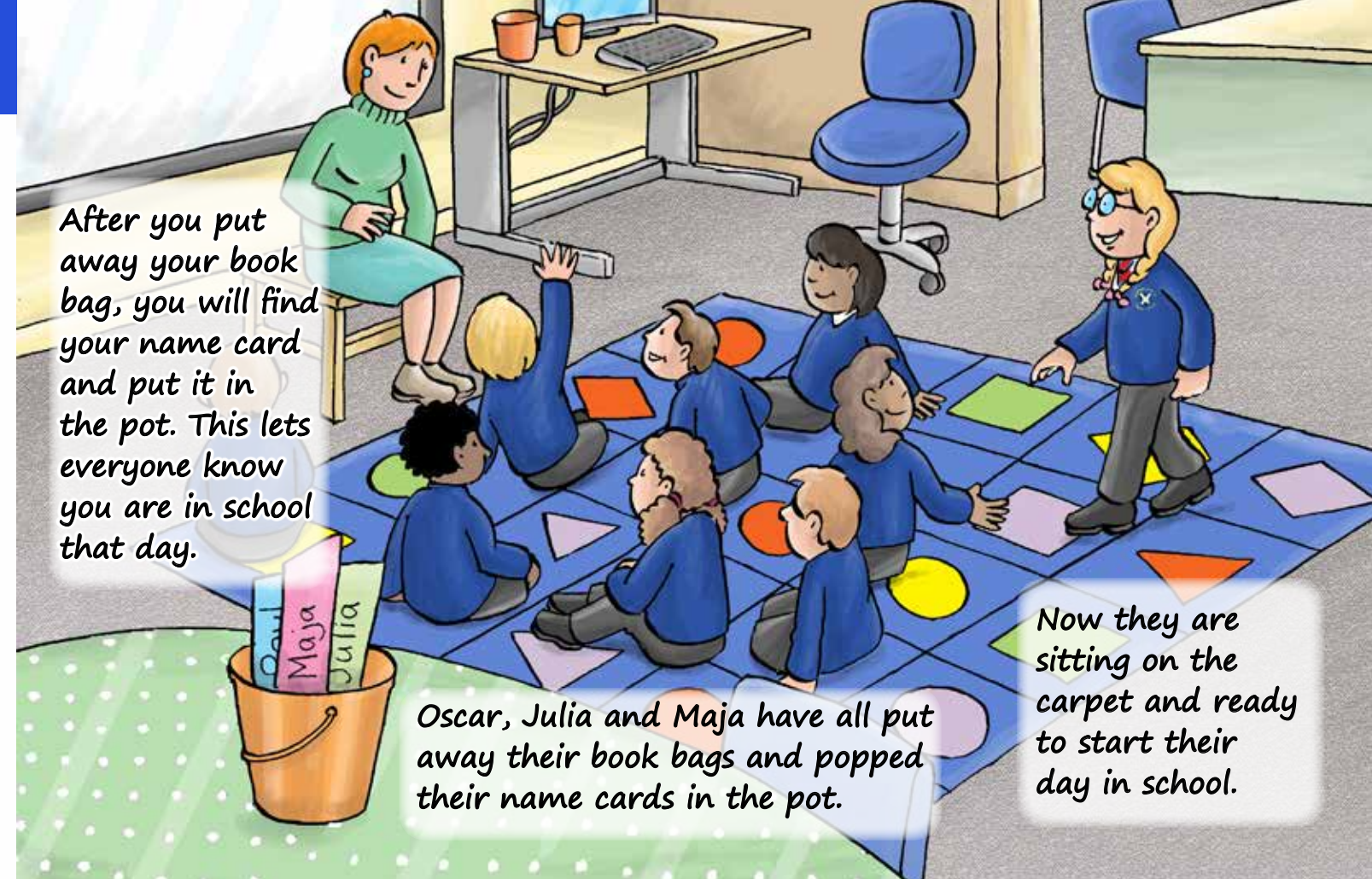
When you get to school, your grown-ups will bring you to the classroom door where your teacher will be waiting to meet you. Then you say goodbye to your grown-ups.

Now they are sitting on the carpet and ready to start their day in school.

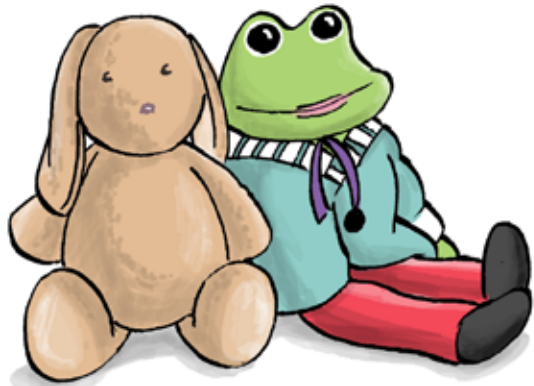

You can also meet Andy the Attendance dog. Andy visits classes to let them know their attendance at school is really good.

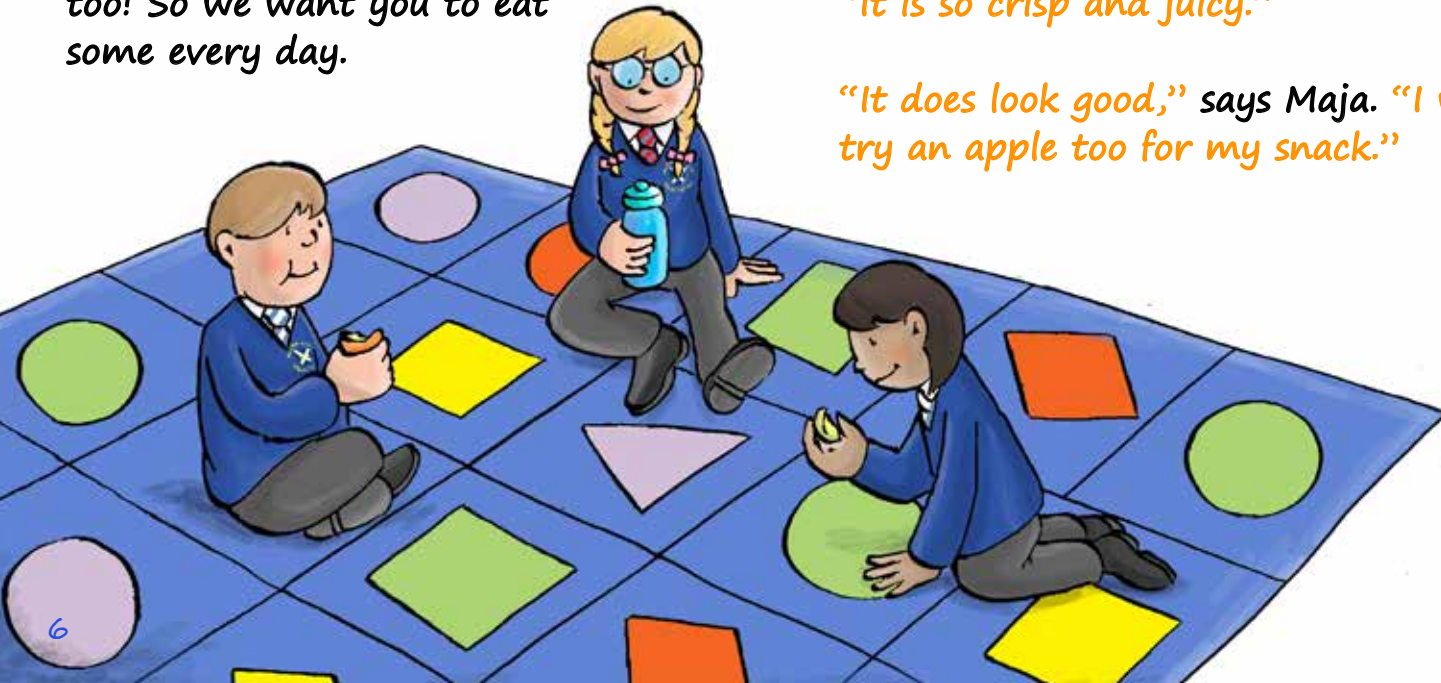

During the morning, you will have a snack of fresh fruit to eat, and water or milk to drink. Fruit is good for you and it tastes great too! So we want you to eat some every day.

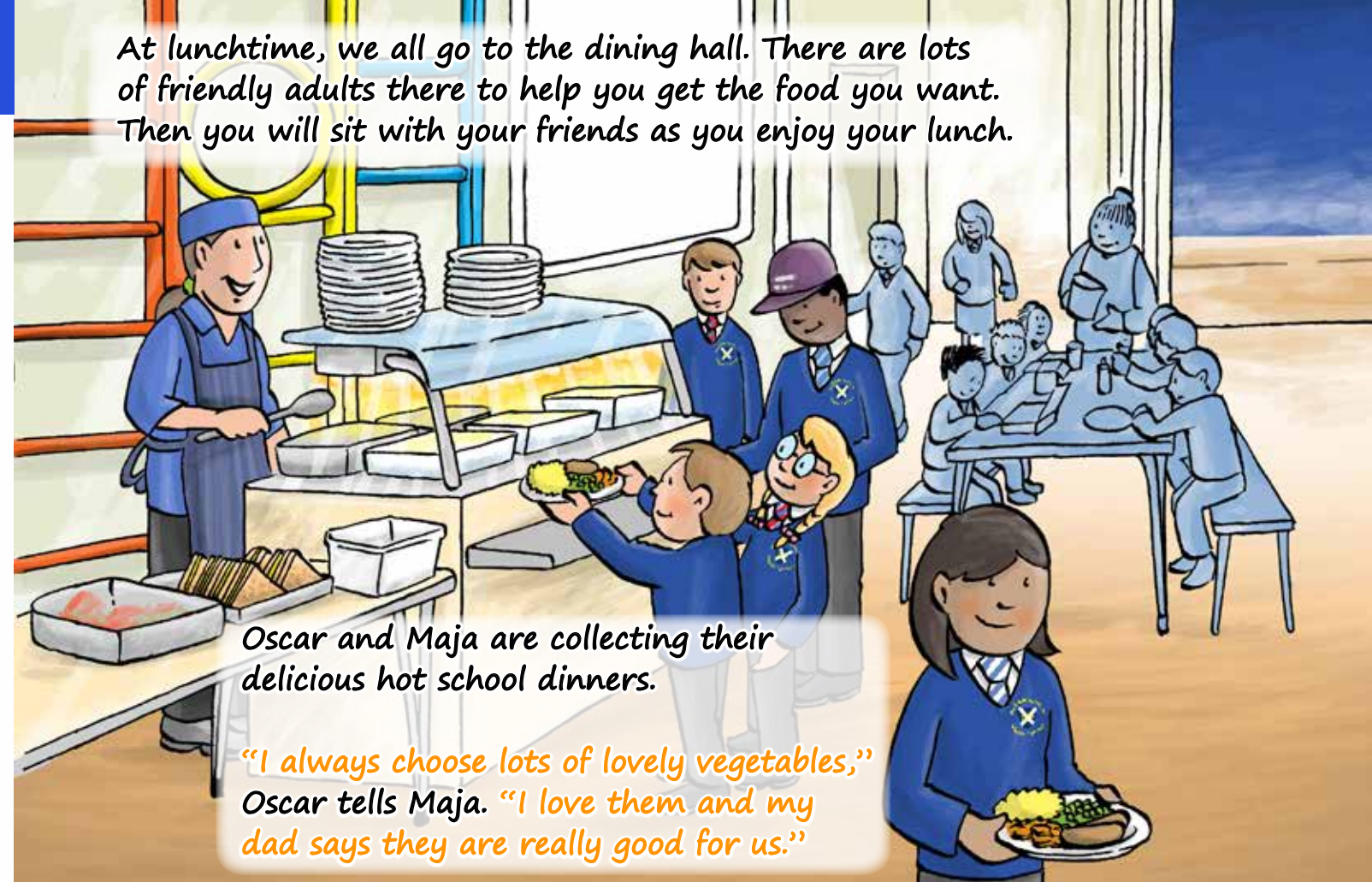


Oscar, Maja and Julia are sitting chatting as they enjoy their morning snack.

He washes his hands with warm water and soap. He loves the bubbles that help him get his hands really clean. Then Oscar dries them and goes back to his class.

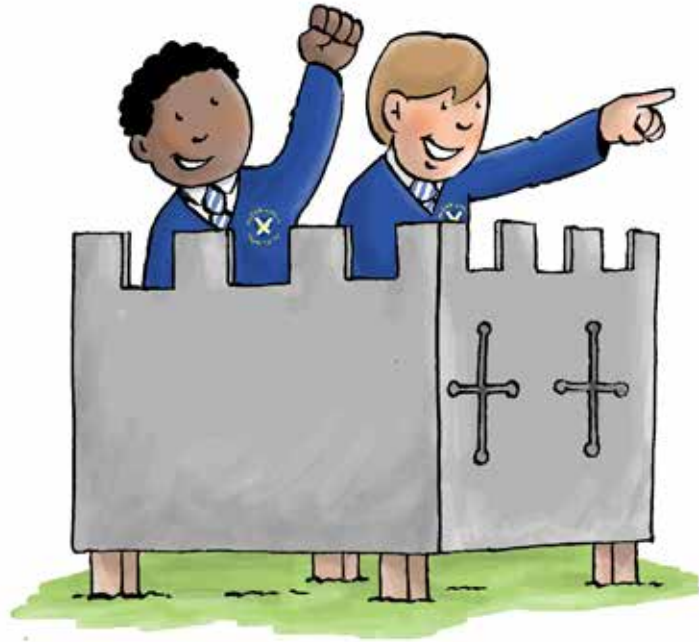


Oscar is so pleased that he practised going to the toilet on his own at home so he could remember everything once he started school.

# What happens in the playground?

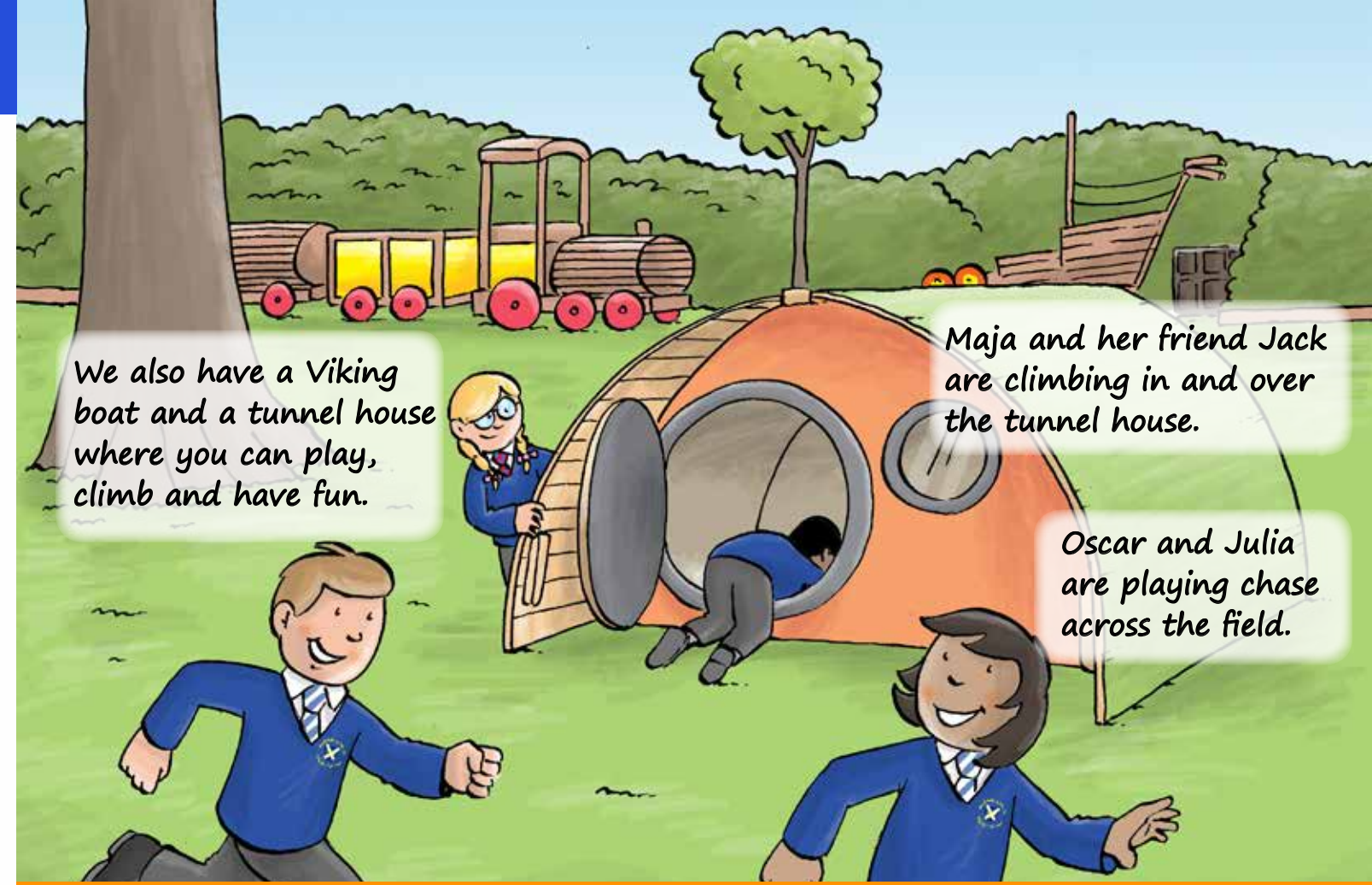
Playing outside is great fun and very good for you too! You get exercise whilst you play, run and explore with your friends.



In the playground you will find:


- A 'Talking Tent' and a wooden house where you can play games and chat with your friends
