Working together


You will come and visit us before you start in September to get to know everyone and where everything is at school.


Your teachers will spend lots of time with you when you start and even look after you when you are having your lunch.






Are you excited about the new work you will do?

We work hard in class and do not waste time. There should never be any name calling.




Do you know what the Golden Rules are?


Emily is planting out some flowers that the children have grown.


How will you support my faith?
