"Please may I go to the toilet?" asks Tomas.

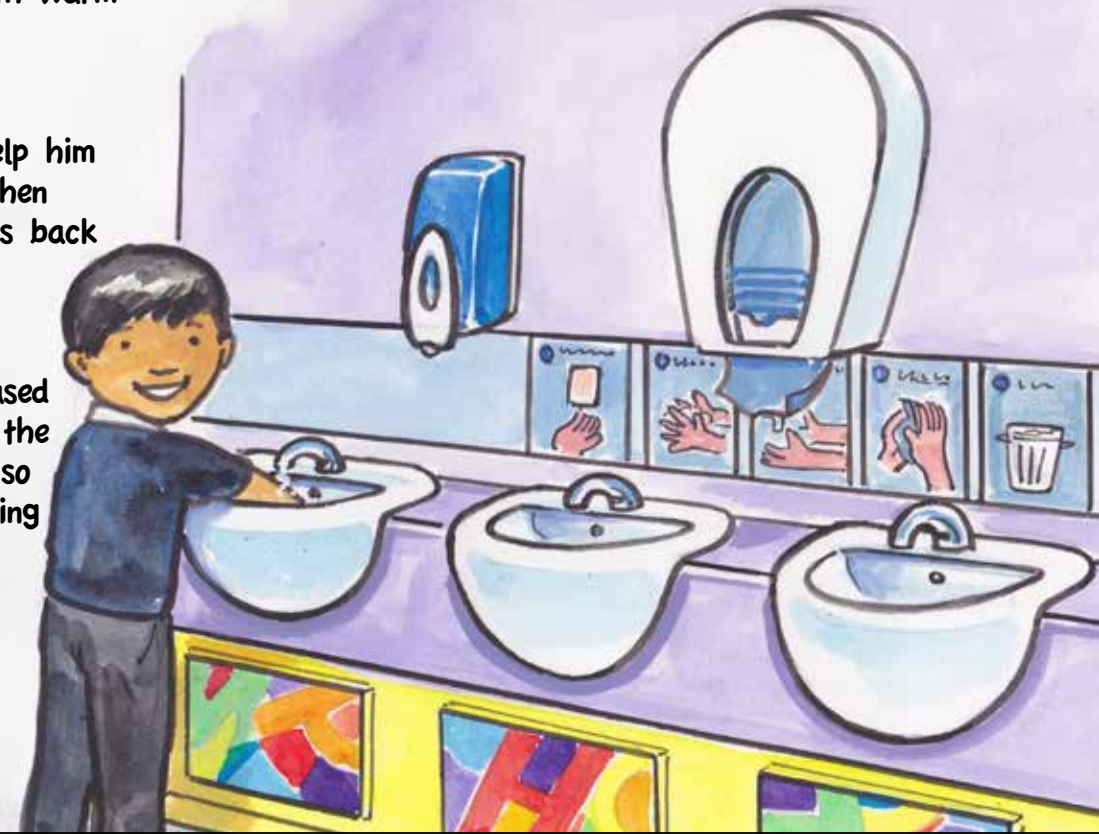
"Yes, of course," says his teacher.

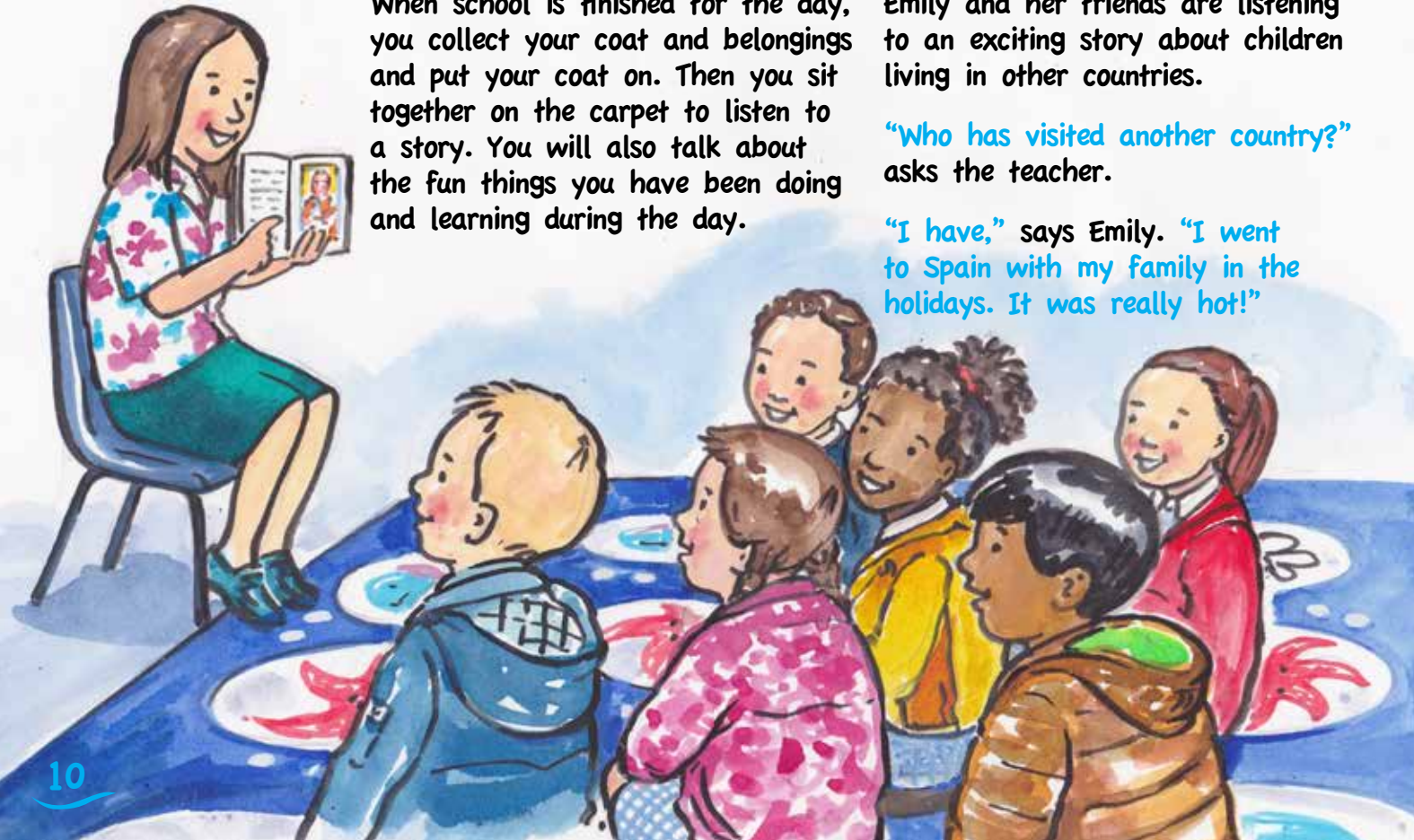
# What happens at the end of the school day?

"Your mum is here, Tomas," says the teacher, and she lets him go to his mum.




"Hello, Tomas," says his mum "Did you have a good day?"
