What happens when I get to school?

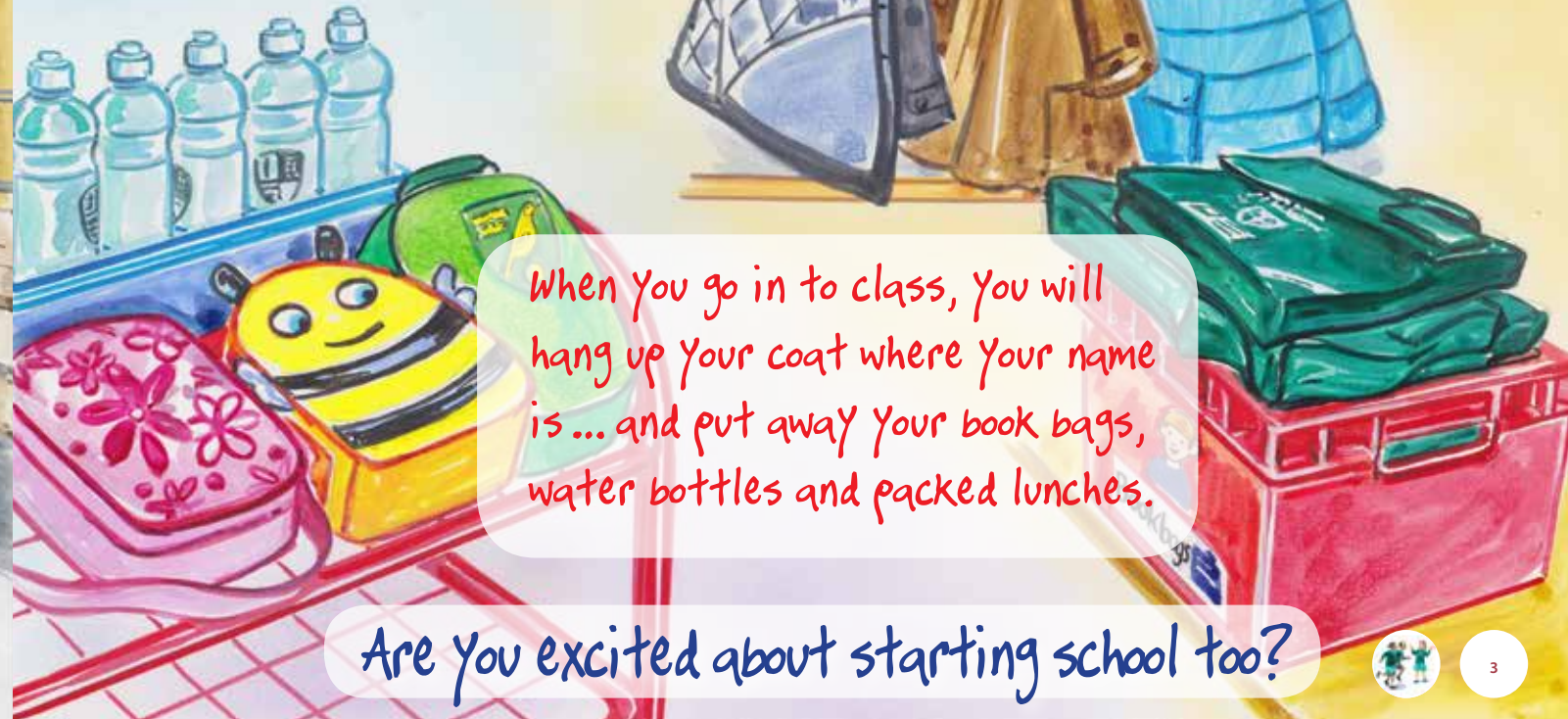
You will wait in the playground with your parents and friends, until the bell rings ... and then go in to class with your teacher.

Your parents and adults will be waiting outside to collect you.

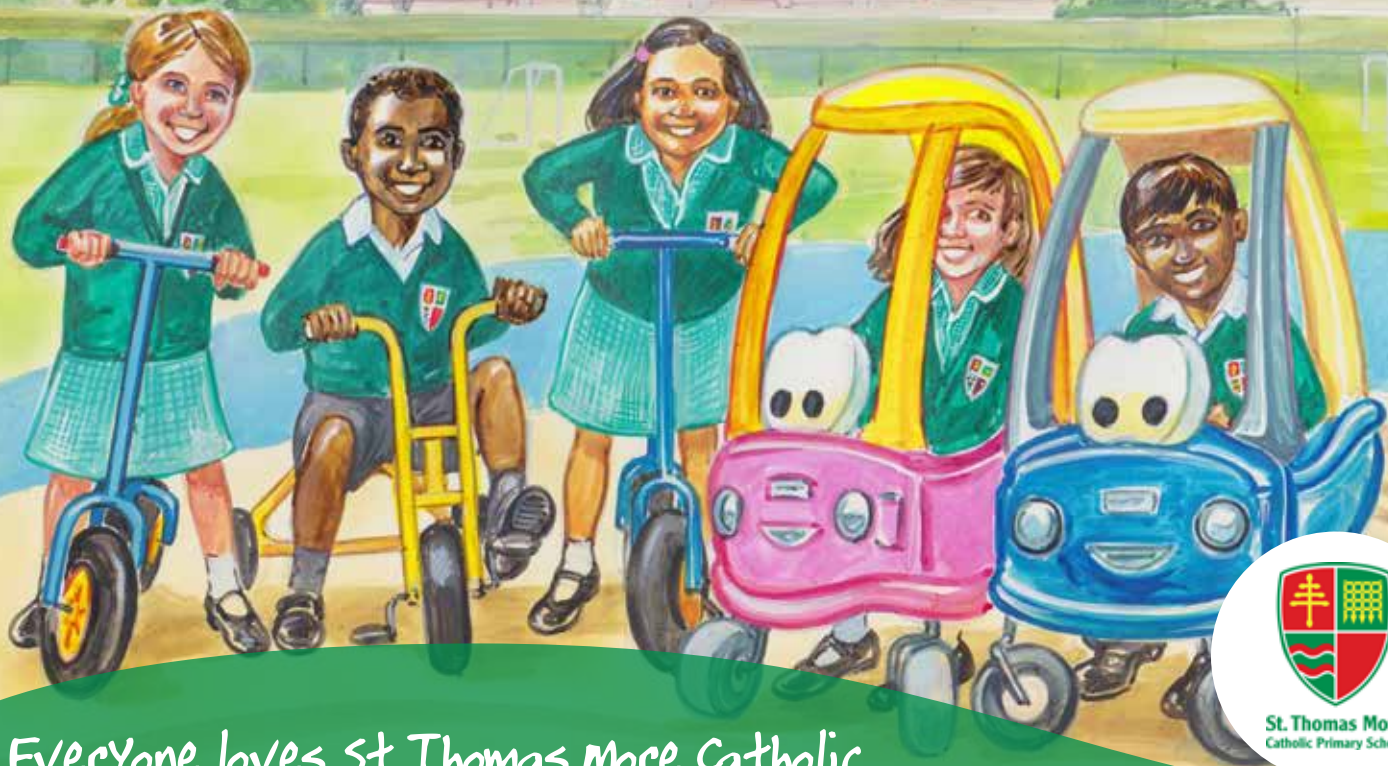
"I can't wait to come back tomorrow," says Azi.
