What will I do at school?

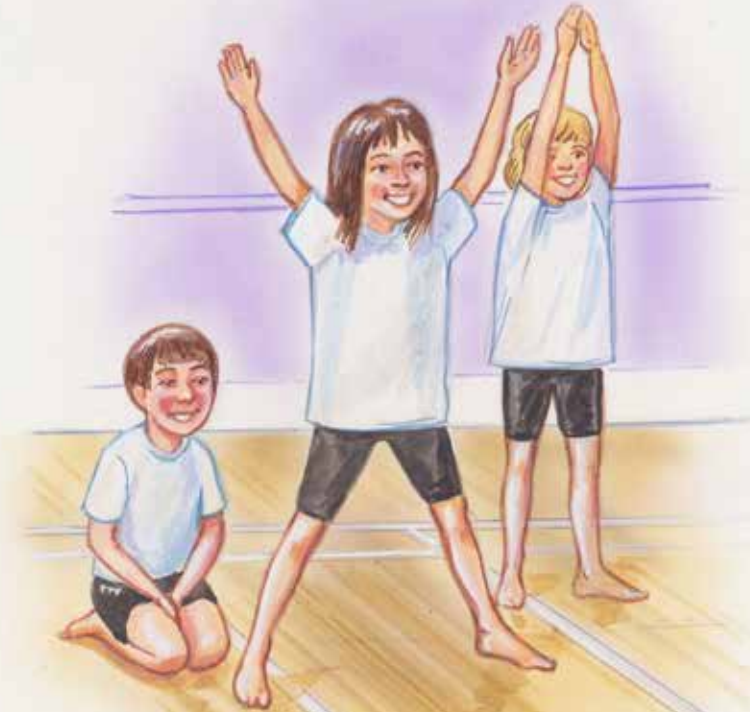
There are lots of fun things to do at school, including

Zofia likes bananas, and Akachi likes milk.

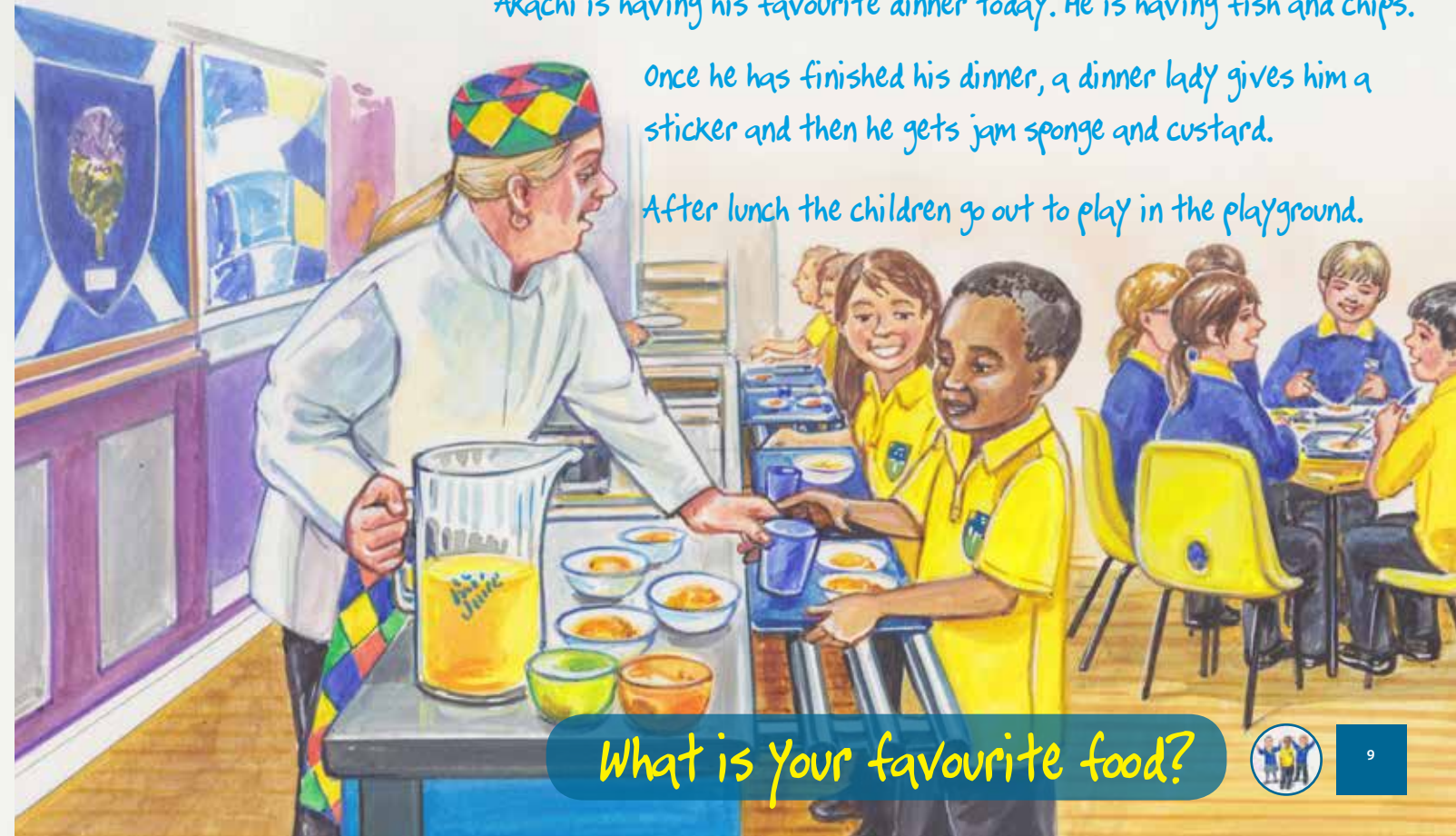


At lunchtime the dinner ladies will help you get the food you like. You can have sandwiches or a hot dinner, and some tasty salad from the salad bar.

What happens at home-time?



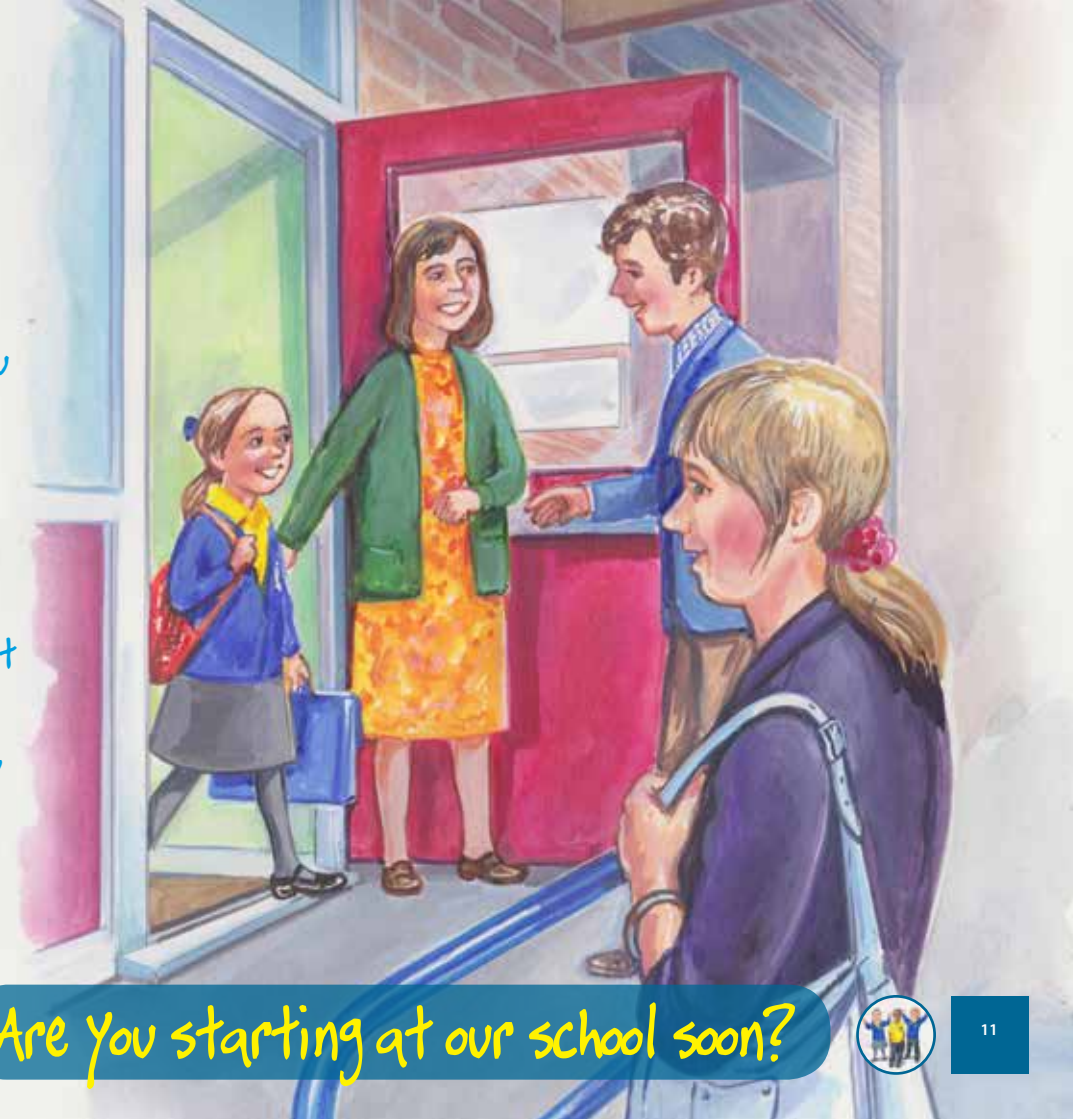
At the end of the school day you will have a mini-assembly in your classroom.
