



Jayden, Meena and Ben are excited to be starting in the Early Years at Hatton School



What happens if I need the toilet?








Jayden has been to the toilet and is now being encouraged to wash and dry his hands.

Can you use a symbol to let us know you need the toilet?


What happens at the end of the school day?
