


Jack is enjoying the sensory circuit.


Ben and Abbie are having fun in their 'Wake and Shake' movement session.

Can you practise using cutlery and going to the toilet on your own?


What happens at the end of the school day?




'Golden Time' is the last ten minutes of your school day when you get to choose an activity you like such as Lego or an iPad.
