



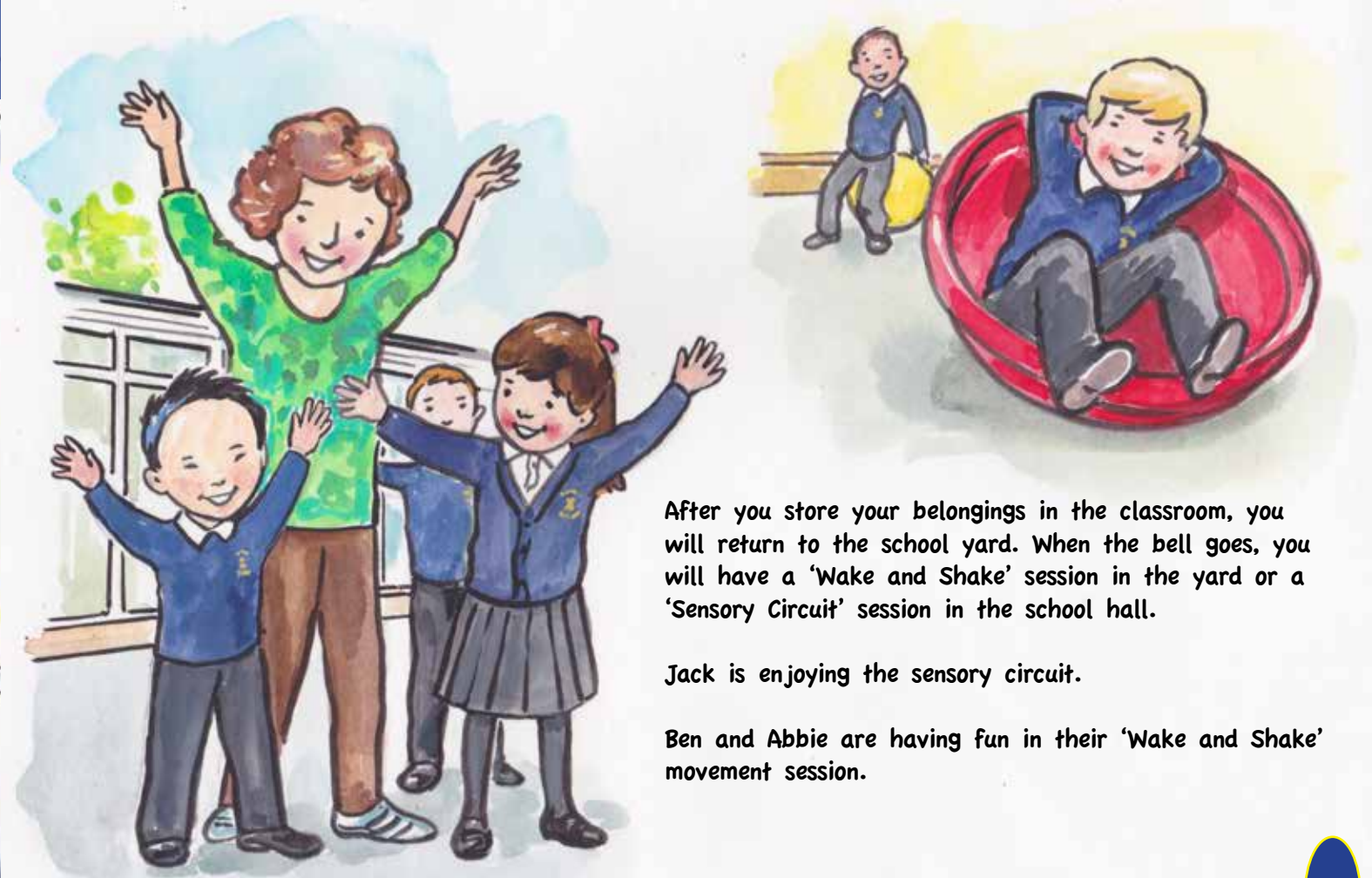
Jack, Ben and Abbie are excited

Ben and Abbie are having fun in their 'Wake and Shake' movement session.

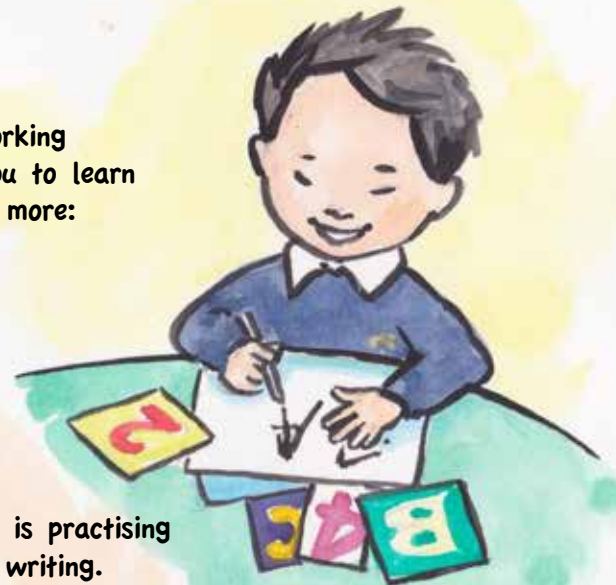
Are you excited about coming to school?

Are you looking forward to learning and doing well at school?

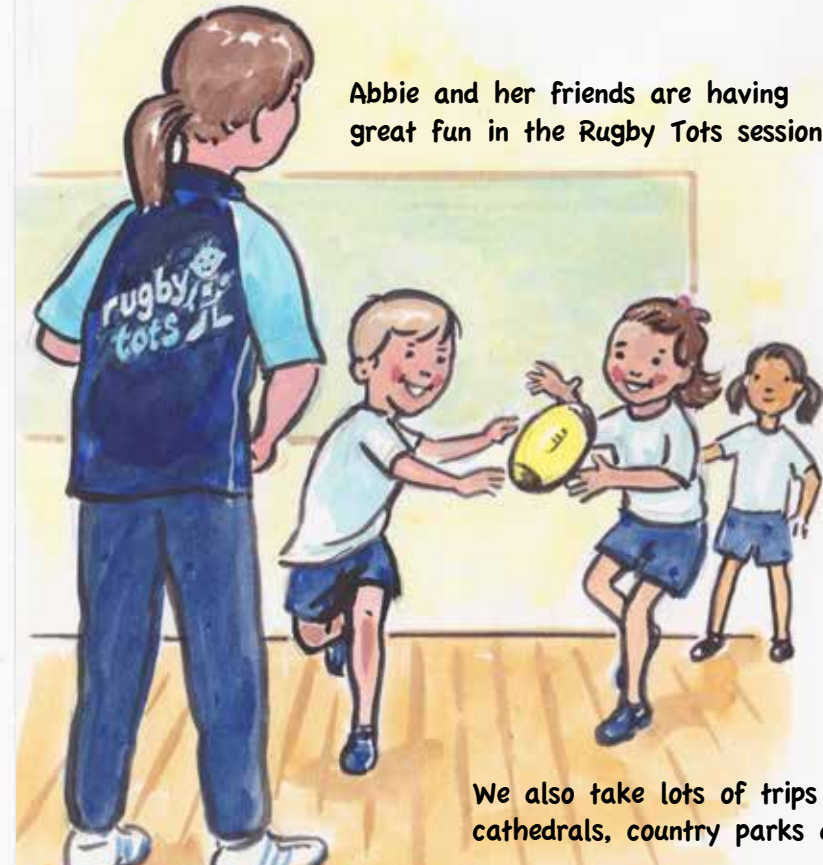
What other activities can I do?

What happens if I need the toilet?

What happens at the end of the school day?

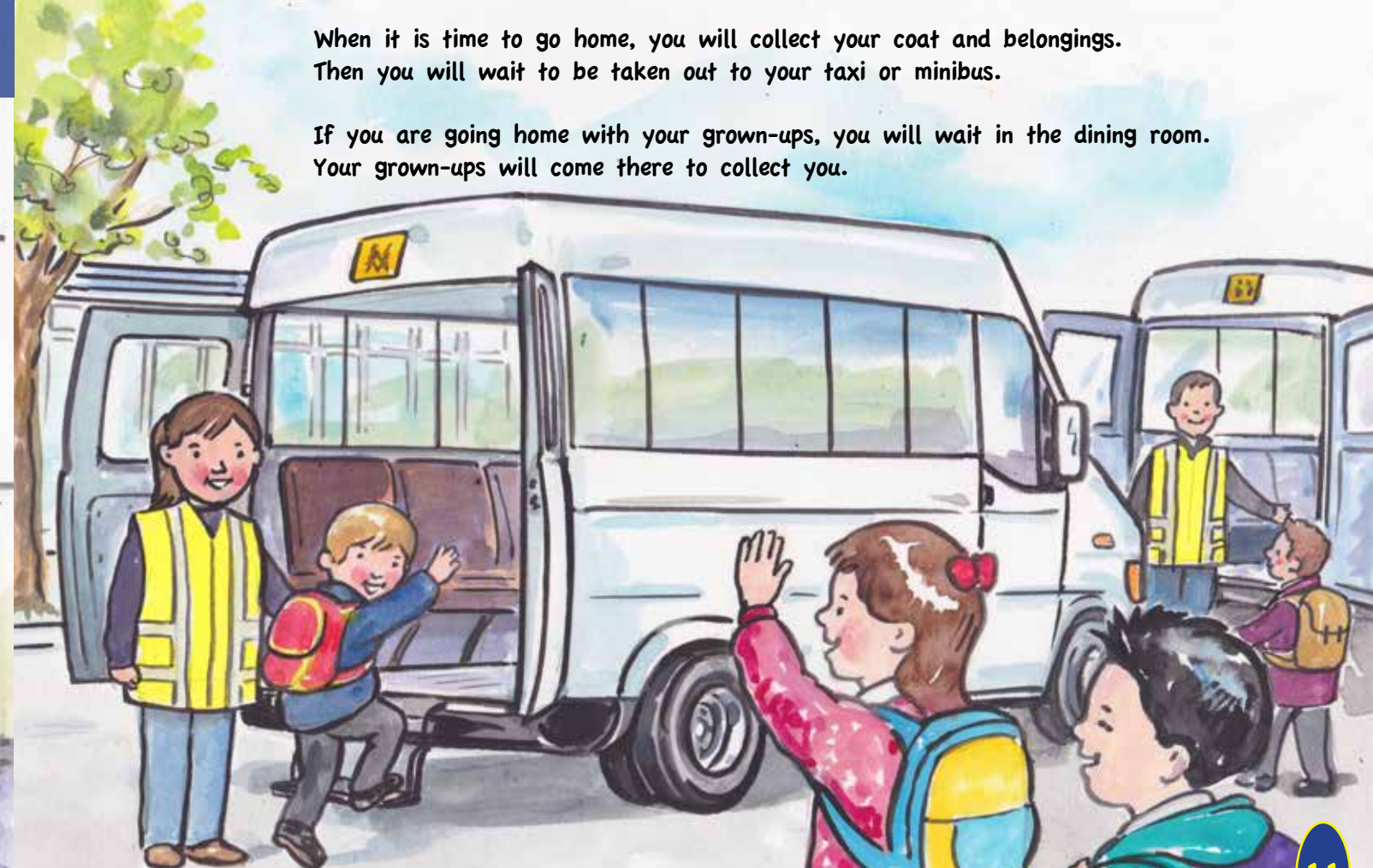


Most classes have 'Golden Time' or a story at the end of the day.
