

Fatima, Kashfi and Charlie are coming to Manor Green Primary School



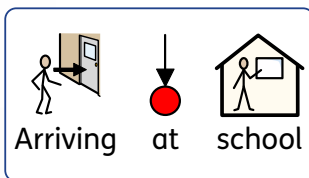
Hello
