What happens when I come to Hope School each day?

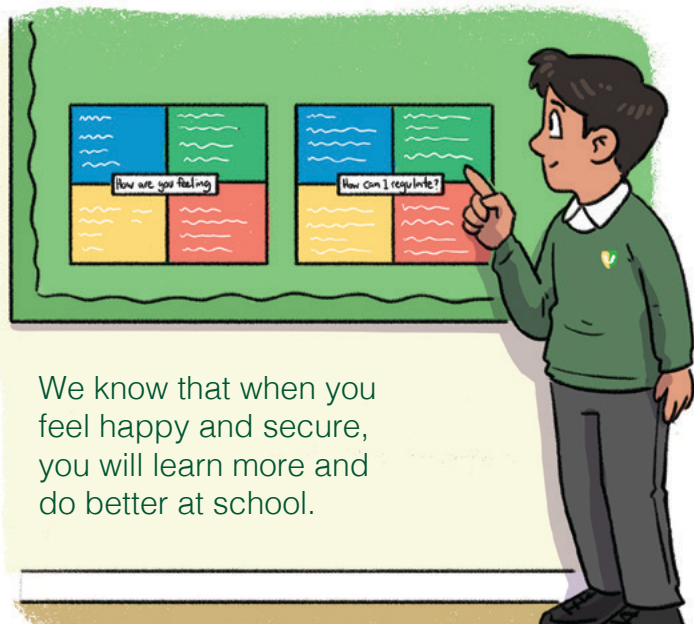
Most children will come to Hope School by taxi. A member of our school team will look after you from the time you are picked up from home all the way to school.

Some children will come in with their grown-ups.



When you arrive at school, your teachers will be waiting to meet you with a big warm welcome and show you to your classroom. At the end of the school day, your teachers will take you back outside to be collected by taxi or by your grown-ups.

What happens when I come to Hope School each day?



We know that when you feel happy and secure, you will learn more and do better at school.

When you go into your classroom, you will show your teacher how you are feeling on the Zones of Regulation display. You will go back to it and update it throughout the day. When learning, everyone should be in the Green Zone and feel happy, content, calm, focused and proud, so we have lots of activities and support to help you get there and stay there!

What will I do in my lessons?

All of your lessons will be fun and help build your confidence.

You will be in a class with a small number of other children, which means that you will have lots of help from your teachers.

You will study the same subjects as children in other schools.

You will study phonics and reading, English, maths, science, history, geography, art, computing, music, RE and PSHE, PE, play and life skills, and lots more.



What else will I do in my lessons?



We love reading at Hope School and you will take books home to read with your grown-ups every week.

On the days that you do PE or outdoor learning, you will wear your PE kit and we will let your grown-ups know which day of the week they are happening.

We will make sure that your grown-ups know all about the brilliant things you have been doing and how well you are getting on at Hope School.

What else will I do in school?

You will do lots of activities outside your classroom as well!

We have outdoor activities where you can build dens and make fires. We have lots of room for sports such as football, a gardening area, and an outdoor playground. We even have a climbing wall!

You will also have regular swimming lessons at our local pool.

You will go on school trips to places such as farms, museums, the library, and the theatre to see a panto, and even some residential trips.
