

Josh, Abiola and Marcus are going to Hope School


Marcus and Abiola are looking at the photos on the door showing who their classmates are.

How will you help me settle into my new class?




How else will you help me in class?


What is your favourite subject?

"It's nice to be in the sunshine."




At lunchtime you can choose what you would like for your lunch. You have a choice of sandwiches, baked potatoes or hot meals. All the food is delicious and healthy.


"What team do you support?" asks Josh.

What happens at the end of the school day?





When it is time to go home, we have 'check out', where we catch up and talk about what we have been doing during the day, and say goodbye to each other.
