At dinner time, the dinner ladies will help you get the food you like. Jamal is having potatoes, broccoli and vegetarian chilli.

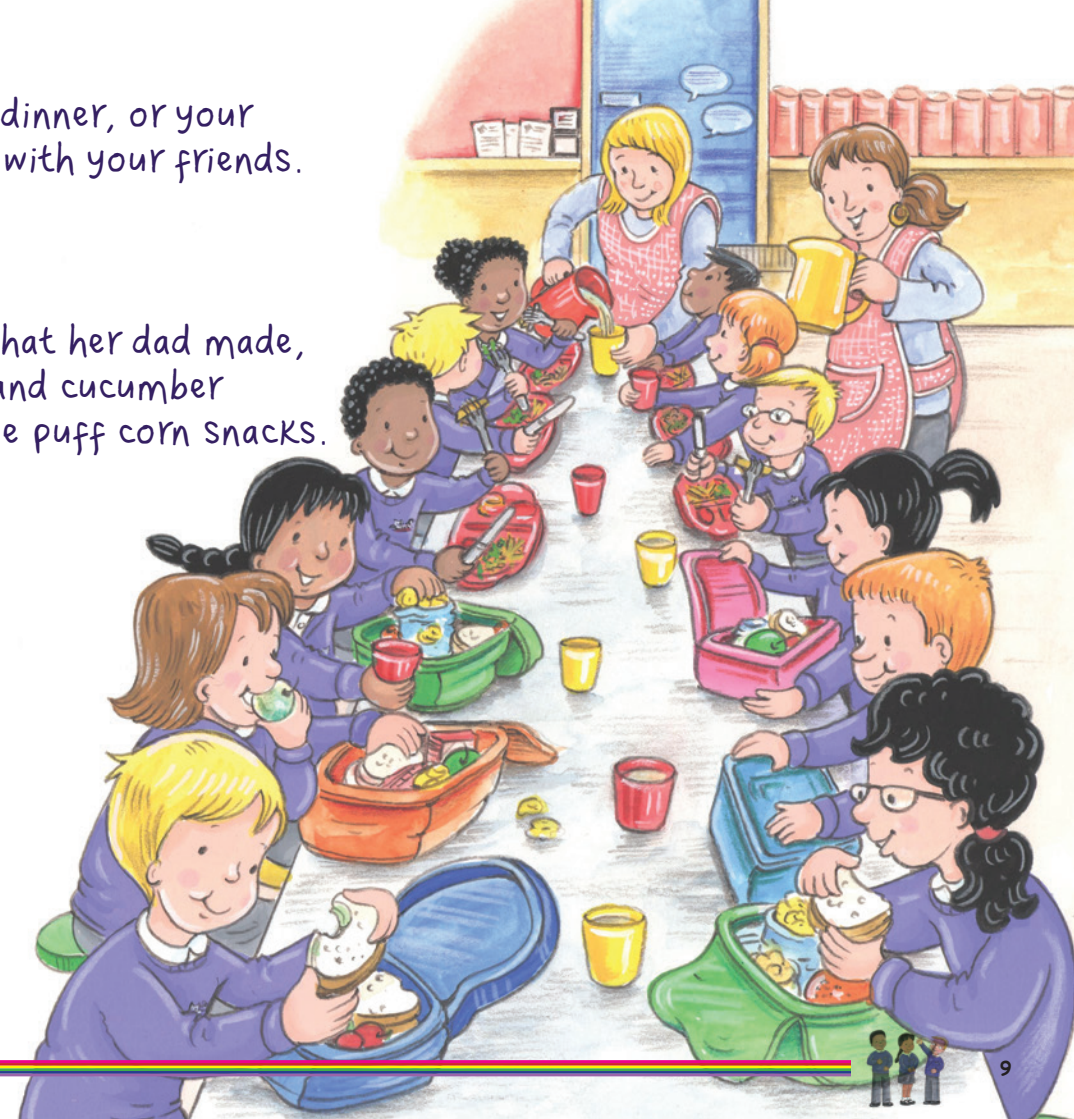


When you have your hot dinner, or your packed lunch, you will sit with your friends.

At home-time you will put on your coat, collect your book bags and water bottles... and sit on the floor waiting for an adult to collect you.

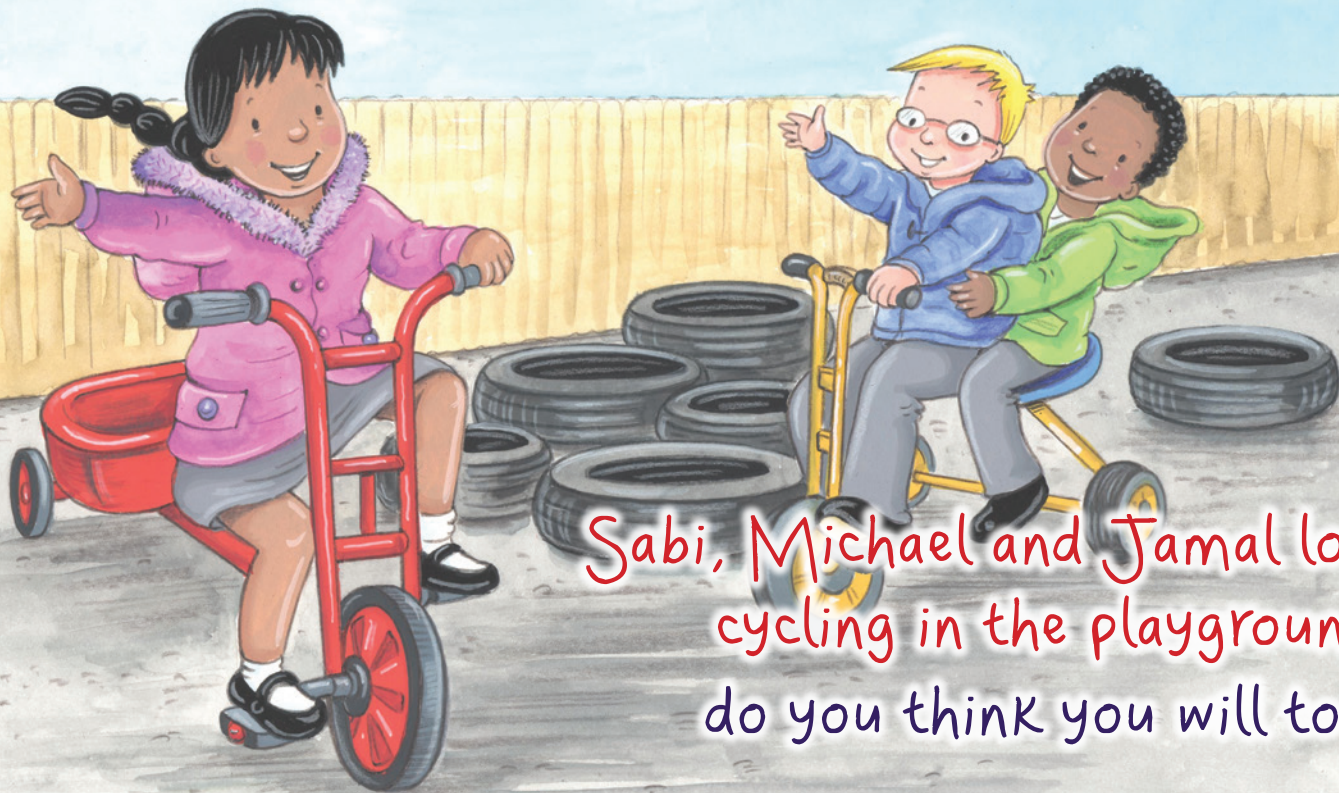
Jamal waves to his parents when they come to collect him. "I have a new book in my book-bag", says Jamal. "It will be great fun to read it with you at home."
